McGAUGHEY FILLIES TO BE CROSS-ENTERED

Still weighing his options, Shug McGaughey will preenter Heavenly Prize (Seeking the Gold) and Inside Information (Private Account) in both the Breeders' Cup Distaff and Classic when those pre-entries are taken tomorrow, but McGaughey admitted vesterday he would probably keep both fillies with their own sex. "I haven't made up my mind, but I'm leaning toward running both in the Distaff," McGaughey said. "I still want to see how both horses are doing and I want to talk to the Phippses more about it. The Distaff is very important. If I were absolutely positive that Inside Information would win the race, maybe I would opt for the Classic for Heavenly Prize." Inside Information's head victory in last Sunday's GI Spinster S. at Keeneland has given McGaughey some room for pause, he said. "Her race at Keeneland was not her best, but she had a big excuse," said the trainer. "Still, I want to make sure that it was that -- a big excuse."

SIXTY NOMINATED TO JAPAN CUP A total of 60 foreign horses have been nominated to next month's Japan Cup. Heading the list of 21 from the United States is Sandpit (Brz) (Baynoun {Ire}), who is expected to make the trip. The six-year-old was second as the favorite in the GI Oak Tree Invitational last time out, Arlington Million winner Awad (Caveat), Oak Tree Invitational victor Northern Spur (Ire) (Sadler's Wells) and Turf Classic winner Turkpasser (Turkoman) are also nominated. There are also a pair of Canadian nominees, including last year's Horse of the Year in that country, Alywow (Alysheba). Europe's representatives, topped by Arc runner-up Freedom Cry (GB) (Soviet Star), consist of 15 from France, six from England and three from Germany; there are also eight Australian and five New Zealand nominations.

FUTURE QUEST INJURED Future Quest (Relaunch), winner in three of his four starts and first in the GII Norfolk S. in his latest, suffered a fracture in his right front leg during the race and will miss the Breeders' Cup Juvenile. "He will not need surgery, but obviously it's going to require some time off," said trainer Ron McAnally. News cont. p3

TAMURE (Sadler's Wells), who beat Spectrum when they last met when getting seven pounds, did not look at his best before the race and disappointed. BAHRI (Riverman) hung badly in the final two furlongs, showing his best distance is a mile, but his fifth-place purse money enabled his trainer, John Dunlop, to overtake Saeed bin Suroor as the season's leading trainer in Britain and he now looks certain to take the title for the first time, as the Dubai horseman is unlikely to have any more runners.
