# LURE NEGOTIATIONS STALLED Ireland's Coolmore Stud, which since August has been in negotiations with the insurers who now own two-time Breeders' Cup champion Lure (Danzig), announced yesterday that plans for the stallion are up in the air. The two parties have been unable to resolve what Coolmore called "fundamental differences" over the agreement to stand the stallion at Coolmore for the 1996 season. Lure became the property of the insurers after failing to get more than 60 percent of his mares in foal last season.

# BEST PAL BACK IN ACTION WEDNESDAY

Golden Eagle Farm's **Best Pal** (\*Habitony), who hasn't raced since finishing fifth behind Cigar in the \$1 million Hollywood Gold Cup July 2, will return to action in Wednesday's featured Skywalker S. at Santa Anita. The seven-year-old gelding, whose bankroll stands at \$5,793,895, blew out for the race yesterday, going a half in :47 1/5. The Cal-bred is prepping for the November 11 \$250,000 Wells Fargo Cal Cup Classic; he faces fellow Grade I winner **Slew Of Damascus** (Slewacide) in the mile test for three-year-olds and up.

## TEAM VALOR TO FORM GENERAL

PARTNERSHIP Team Valor partners Barry Irwin and Jeff Siegel, whose groups have raced major winners Star of Cozzene (Cozzene) and Prized (Kris S.), have announced they will form a limited partnership to buy, race and sell horses over the next five years, and that they will no longer syndicate horses. A California corporation owned wholly by Irwin and Siegel, Team Valor will be the general partner of the limited partnership. Two-hundred units at \$25,000 each will be offered in the partnership before the closing date of Nov. 22. "Our goal is to convert to a corporation and go public in the year 2000," said Irwin.

SILKEN CAT TO MISS BREEDERS' CUP Undefeated Silken Cat (Storm Cat), an impressive winner of all three of her starts in Canada including the Mazarine S. in her last outing by 3 ¼ lengths, will not be pointed for the Oct. 28 Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies, according to trainer Mark Frostad. "She is sore behind," explained Frostad. "She missed a week's training. We X-rayed her and couldn't find anything else, so it must be kind of like a muscle pull." Frostad said that Silken Cat would be given the winter off and brought back next year.
