BREEDERS' CUP HOPEFULS BREEZE Heavenly Prize (Seeking the Gold), who has been cross-entered in the Breeders' Cup Classic and Distaff, breezed fiveeighths at Belmont Saturday morning in 1:01.51. "I thought she worked great," said trainer Shug McGaughey of the four-year-old filly. "Her two works since the (Oct. 7) Beldame have been what I wanted. We'll go a sharp half Thursday to get her in the game plan." Sunday morning, a trio of McGaughey trainees prepped for the Breeders' Cup over Belmont's sloppy surface. My Flag (Easy Goer), second in the GI Frizette Oct. 7, breezed five furlongs in 1:02.29 for the Juvenile Fillies, Millionairess Inside Information (Private Account) drilled a half-mile in :47.12 for the Distaff, and Our Emblem (Mr. Prospector) tuned up for the Sprint with a five furlong move in :59.64. "My Flag looked strong; she does like the mud," McGaughey said. "She was feeling so good, in fact, we decided to go five-eighths instead of a half with her, just to take the edge off." Earl of Barking (Ire) (Common Grounds {GB}) and Ventiquattrofogli (Ire) (Persian Bold {Ire}), winner of the GII Col. F.W. Koester H. at a mile on the Santa Anita turf Oct. 7, both worked on the West Coast Sunday morning; the turf runners have been designated as second and third alternates respectively for the Breeders' Cup Mile. Earl of Barking worked five furlongs in 1:00 3/5 at Santa Anita, while Ventiquattrofogli breezed six panels in a bullet 1:13 3/5 at Hollywood Park. Also prepping for the Breeders' Cup on the West Coast yesterday was Track Gal (Track Barron), who went six furlongs in 1:12 1/5 over Santa Anita's fast main track. The four-year-old filly will be trying for her seventh straight victory in the Sprint.

FORMER TRAINER LESTER HOLT DEAD Lester Holt, a former trainer on the Southern California circuit, died of cancer Saturday at his home in Del Mar. He was 86. Some of the best horses Holt trained were multiple stakes-winners Prince Spellbound, Don B. and Sharp Curve. Holt was also well-known in the San Diego area for being co-proprietor of four restaurants. In addition, he remained involved in horse ownership at the time of his death and one of his runners, Don's Memory, finished fifth in Saturday's colts and geldings division of the California Stallion S. HEVER GOLF ROSE READY FOR SPRINT Hever Golf Rose (GB) (Efisio {GB}), a stakes-winner in five different European nations this year, jetted out of Britain Sunday morning along with the rest of her compatriots headed to New York for Saturday's Breeders' Cup. "She worked on a dirt bend at Lingfield Saturday morning and I was delighted by the way she went," said her trainer Joe Naughton. "I understand there is plenty of rain about in the New York area. But our filly has won on every sort of ground from firm to heavy, so that should not make any great difference to her chance. If it came up sloppy, I suppose it would mean more kick-back. But Hever Golf Rose is very tough and won't give up without a fight." When asked about his four-year-old filly's chances in the Sprint, Naughton responded, "I'm told the front two in the betting -- Not Surprising (Medieval Man) and You and I (Kris S.)--are the ones to beat. But if our filly and Lake Coniston (Ire) (Bluebird) run up to their best form, there is no reason why they shouldn't do well." Meanwhile, MGSW Owington (GB) (Green Desert), who will be ridden in the Sprint by Britain's champion jockey Frankie Dettori, will wear blinkers for the first and final time Saturday. Win or lose this weekend, the colt is set to retire to Lord Derby's New England Stud in Newmarket immediately after his return to Britain.




