**RACING CANCELED AT BELMONT** Yesterday's card at Belmont Park was canceled just before the first race due to high winds and heavy rains. The featured GII Jamaica H, was also canceled, and will not be rescheduled. Simulcast wagering on races from Keeneland and Santa Anita, and on the Calder Derby, continued, but patrons at the track Saturday were issued rain checks for admission good any day except Breeders' Cup Day; they also received refunds for parking, and will be able to exchange yesterday's program for a program any day but Breeders' Cup Day. Explained New York Racing Association Chairman and President Kenny Noe, Jr., "The safety of the horses and riders is our primary concern. I apologize to our patrons who made their way out here in tough weather, and hope they understand the reason for this decision."

PELDER AND MISSED FLIGHT TO STUD A pair of European Group winners have been retired and will go to stud next season. Pelder (Ire) (Be My Guest), easy winner of this year's G1 Prix Ganay, will stand at Benham Stud in Berkshire, England at a fee of \$4,500. The five-year-old, Italy's highweight two-year-old colt in '92, was also successful in Italy's G1 Gran Criterium at two and G1 Premio Parioli at three. Missed Flight (GB) (Dominion {GB}), first in the G2 Sandown Mile and G3 Prix de Meautry this year, will go to stud for 1996 as well. The five-year-old, also a Group winner at four and twice G1SP in '95, had been expected to make a bid for the Breeders' Cup Mile, but a minor injury sustained in a morning gallop ended his career. "The injury wasn't serious, but it meant he couldn't run again this year. So, after he had such a good season, we thought this would be the best time to find him a place at stud," said his trainer, Chris Wall. Missed Flight will stand at Wood Farm Stud in Shropshire, England for a fee of \$2,800.

#### VIRGINIA CARNIVAL TO FRANKS Virginia Carni-

val (Carnivalay), a ½-length winner of last Saturday's GIII Bay Meadows Derby, has been sold to owner John Franks for an undisclosed sum. The three-year-old colt, who has won five of nine starts, was expected to be shipped to trainer Jack Van Berg's Hollywood Park barn today. Former owners Robert Domush and James Egide purchased Virginia Carnival just two weeks before the Bay Meadows Derby, after the colt had won three straight allowance starts on the East Coast. Mons, the odds-on favourite, set a moderate pace and still led a guarter-mile out, when he was challenged by Even Top, but that one held the lead only briefly as Beauchamp King made a strong finishing move at the eighth pole and went on to win comfortably. Winning owner/breeder Erik Penser, who paid \$23,200 to supplement the colt to the race, said it was money well-spent. "We did some homework and it suggested to us that there would be a small field. Beauchamp King is an improving horse and we intend to aim him for the 2000 Guineas. We will think about the Derby only after we have seen how he gets on at Newmarket."
