KEENELAND'S FALL MEET CONCLUDES

Buoved by the addition of many new out-of-state betting outlets, total wagering for Keeneland's 16-day, Oct. 7 through Oct. 28 fall meeting increased by more than 67 percent from a year ago. Fall records for mutuel handle--\$69,999,992--and average daily handle--\$4,375,000--were set. Each was up 67.6 percent from 1994. New York, Florida and Illinois contributed over \$19.5 million to the total, as for the first time in the fall, outlets in each of those states simulcasted full cards from Keeneland. On-track betting totaled \$19,047,677, a 4.3 percent decrease from 1994, while the average daily handle of \$1,190,480 was down a similar amount from last year. Keeneland's on-track attendance totaled 196,499 for an average of 12,281 daily. That was down 9.2 percent from 216,359 in 1994. Officials attributed declines in attendance and handle to poor weather during the last half of the meeting. "Through the first nine days, attendance and betting were even with last year," explained Keeneland President Bill Greely. "Then we experienced cold, threatening weather on the last two weekends of the meeting." Horsemen competed for a record \$5,873,338 in purses, a daily average of \$367,084. D. Wayne Lukas led the trainers' standings with 17 wins. It was the seventh time in the last eight years Lukas won or tied for the fall training title. William T. Young's Overbrook Farm won 10 races, more than any other owner. Shane Sellers led the jockevs' standings with 19 wins.

ASCOT KNIGHT COLT TOPS ARKANSAS SALE

A bay weanling colt by Ascot Knight--Stray Flight (Viceregal) brought a sales-topping \$26,000 at Saturday's Arkansas Breeders' Sales Co. Mixed Sale in Little Rock. Consigned by Starr Farms, the colt, a half-brother to multiple stakes-winners Sparrow Lake (Apalachee) and Ever Steady (Steady Growth), was purchased by Dan White. Overall, 265 horses were sold for a gross of \$926,200 and an average of \$3,495.
