TALKIN MAN RETIRED Talkin Man (With Approval), Canada's Champion Two-Year-Old Colt in 1994. has been retired. The Canadian-bred colt won three stakes at Woodbine last year, then ventured to New York this past spring to capture the GII Gotham S. by seven lengths and the GII Wood Memorial by 7 3/4. Talkin Man raced twice more, finishing 12th in the Kentucky Derby and sixth in the Preakness before undergoing surgery to remove a broken splint bone in his right front leg. The dark bay had recently returned to training at Woodbine under the care of trainer Roger Attfield, but injured a suspensory ligament that resulted in his retirement. The announcement was made jointly by owners Kinghaven Farms, Angus Glen Farm and Peter Wall. Three-year-old Talkin Man retires with five wins from 10 starts for earnings of \$677,967. Plans regarding his career as a stallion have not yet been determined.

SERENA'S SONG TO RACE IN 1996 Trainer D. Wayne Lukas reported that his seven Breeders' Cup starters all came out of Saturday's championship day in fine shape. Although Lukas failed to win a Breeders' Cup race, his runners finished second, third and sixth in the Juvenile Fillies; second, third and fourth in the Juvenile; and fifth in the Distaff. Lukas said Distaff starter and probable three-year-old filly champion Serena's Song (Rahy) is doing well. "Serena's Song is doing great. She came out of the race perfect. She won't run again this year, but she'll be back next year, although I don't know anything more specific." The trainer added, "All of our horses came back great. It's amazing considering the conditions they were running in."

HARAYIR TO BREEDING SHED Harayir (Gulch), winner of this year's G1 British 1000 Guineas but forced to miss the Breeders' Cup Mile Saturday after injuring a hind-leg tendon, has been retired. No definite plans have yet been made for Sheikh Hamdan al Maktoum's three-year-old filly, but she will reside at Shadwell Stud in Norfolk, England until connections have chosen a stallion as her first mate next season. Trainer Dick Hern described Harayir as "very game, sound and with a wonderful constitution." Bred in Kentucky and raced solely in England, Harayir won the G2 Talkland Lowther S. at two, then came back this year to take the 1000 Guineas, G2 Tripleprint Celebration Mile, G3 Hungerford S. and most recently the G2 Challenge S. at Newmarket October 12. She retires with six victories from 13 career starts for earnings of \$485,831.

Back against stakes company here, the bay filly took the lead at the start and never looked back, striding under the wire a half-length the best for her fifth stakes victory. "This horse has speed and she can run any way you want," said winning jockey Martin Pedroza. "(Trainer) Barry Abrams told me if we're going to beat these fillies to just let her break and go. I think if I would have sent her along like I did today, she probably would have won her last race too." GSW Angi Go rallied from sixth and last for the place spot, while even-money favorite PIRATE'S REVENGE (Pirate's Bounty), returning from a fourmonth hiatus, was never a factor, finishing sixth.

RED BISHOP RETIRED TO STUD Red Bishop

(Silver Hawk), a graded stakes winner on three continents, has been retired to stud at Margaux Farm in Midway, Kentucky. The seven-year-old horse, whose earnings total \$1.3 million, posted victories in the G1 Queen Elizabeth II Cup in Hong Kong April 1, the GI San Capistrano H. at Santa Anita April 23, the Hong Kong International Vase and the G3 Brigadier Gerard S. in England. He finished on the board in 18 of 21 starts, and last raced July 8 in England, finishing third to Halling in the G1 Coral Eclipse S. The stallion will stand as the property of Margaux Farm and Darley Stud Mgt. Inc. with a fee of \$4,000 live foal, payable November 1.

TEJANO RUN ON THE MEND AGAIN Roy Monroe's Tejano Run (Tejano), a fast-closing second in the 1995 Kentucky Derby, continues to recuperate at Longfield Farm in Goshen, Kentucky from three surgeries this year. The three-year-old chestnut had an ankle chip removed following the Preakness S., throat surgery a short time later then colic surgery on the heels of the throat procedure, trainer Kenneth McPeek said yesterday. McPeek said he's looking at a four-year-old campaign for the MGSW, who took both the GII Breeders' Futurity at Keeneland and GIII Kentucky Cup Juvenile at two. McPeek will take Tejano Run to Florida for winter training.

LINDON LIME, NEVER WAVERING RETIRED

The five-year-old gelding Lindon Lime (Green Dancer), a five-time stakes-winner of \$668,593, has been retired. The classy grass runner, who took the Sycamore S. at Keeneland in his last start Oct. 12, broke the sesamoid bone in his left foreleg during a gallop last week and was retired immediately. Surgery wasn't necessary, according to his trainer Elliott Walden. Among Lindon Lime's stakes tallies was the GIII Niagara H. at Woodbine in August. Also retired last week was Walden trainee Never Wavering (Wavering Monarch). The multiple stakes-winning sprinter earned \$435,516 from 12 career victories. He last raced in a Keeneland allowance Oct. 25, finishing eighth. He retires sound, said Walden, who added that the six-year-old will stand stud in 1996 at Triple E Farm in Ocala, Florida.

DIGAMIST MOVES TO MARGAUX FARM

Digamist (Blushing Groom {Fr}), winner of the G1 Heinz 57 Phoenix S. in Ireland in 1987, has been moved to Margaux Farm in Midway, Kentucky. The 10-year-old stallion previously stood at Crown Colony Farm in Lexington. Digamist won three of seven career starts for earnings of \$263,161. The chestnut has sired four stakes horses in his first two limited crops, including Ready, winner of the Centurion Trophy S.; Crusade, third in the Lord Avie S.; Arenea Diadema, second in the Oppenheim Rennen and third in the Kolner Sprint-Preis; and Digarah, third in the Premio Pisa. Digamist will stand as the property of Margaux Farm Inc. and Richard and Peggy McBride for \$3,000 live foal, payable November 1.
