DAVID WILLMOT TO HEAD OJC George

Hendrie, Chairman of the Board of Trustees of The Ontario Jockey Club, announced yesterday that the Board has accepted the recommendation of the Search Committee that David S. Willmot be appointed President and Chief Executive Officer of the OJC as of January 1, 1996. Willmot succeeds Patrick J. Keenan, who announced in June that he would like to retire at the end of the year. Keenan will continue to serve as a Trustee and a member of the OJC Executive Committee. Willmot, owner of Kinghaven Farm, has been a Trustee since 1984 and has served as an active member of many Board committees, including the Harness and Thoroughbred Racing committees.

LAKEWAY TO RACE AT CHURCHILL Lakeway

(Seattle Slew), third in the Breeders' Cup Distaff in her last outing, will make at least two more starts this year, both in November at Churchill Downs, according to trainer Gary Jones. "I'm going to run her in the (\$200,000) Churchill Downs Budweiser Breeders' Cup on the 11th at a mile, and then back on the 23rd in the (GIII, \$200,000a) Falls City H. going a mile and an eighth," said Jones. "She ran down a little bit in the Breeders' Cup, but that was to be expected with the track." Jones said he and owner Mike Rutherford would discuss further plans for the four-year-old filly later in the year. "It depends on her next two races," said Jones. "Mike talked about the Apple Blossom (April 12 at Oaklawn Park), but we want to see how the next two races go before we decide that."

SUPREMO TO LANE'S END Supremo (Gone West) has been retired from racing and will enter stud at Lane's End Farm. He will stand the 1996 season for \$5,000 guaranteed live foal as the property of a syndicate. Winner of the GII Norfolk S. at two, Supremo placed in two other graded stakes as a juvenile, winning two of seven starts for career earnings of \$228,250. Bred in Kentucky by Robert Berger, Supremo was the \$400,000 sales topper at last year's April Two-Year-Olds-in-Training sale at Keeneland, where he was purchased by trainer Richard Mulhall on behalf of The Thoroughbred Corp. Last month, Supremo returned from a 10-month layoff due to a pulled suspensory to finish second in an allowance at Keeneland. News cont. p2

RECORD HANDLE AT CALDER Despite suffering a setback when full-card simulcasting was halted for more than two months after a brief 13-day trial, the 1995 Calder meet produced a record total handle, excluding full-card simulcasting, of \$265,933,979, a 12 percent increase over 1994. When the \$20,835,094 handle from full-card simulcasting is added, the total shows a 20 percent rise over last year. "When I consider where we were in August, I am very pleased with the final results," said Calder President Ken Dunn. "We also made up ground in attendance over the last two months, so I believe our Tropical Meet (which begins today and runs through January 2) will be outstanding." Attendance, which averaged 6,030 during the 123-day meet, was down just 4.8 percent from 1994.

RUHLMANN TO PAYSON STUD Ruhlmann (Mr. Leader), a two-time GISW winner who won or placed in 12 stakes and retired with earnings of \$1,824,353, is moving to Kentucky and will stand the 1996 breeding season at Payson Stud in Lexington. A track-record setter going a mile at Santa Anita, the stallion formerly stood at California's Cardiff Stud; his leading earner from just two crops to race is stakes winner Top Ruhl, a GISP filly who has bankrolled \$145,118. Ruhlmann will stand for a fee of \$5,000, live foal, and is expected to arrive at Payson before the November sales.

NORTHERN PARK TO GAINESWAY Northern Park

(Northern Dancer) is being transferred from Kirsten Rausing's Lanwades Stud in Newmarket, England to stand at Graham J. Beck's Gainesway Farm in Lexington, it was announced yesterday. The seven-yearold, the very last stakes-winning son of Northern Dancer and the highest-priced yearling of 1989 when he sold for \$2.8 million at the Keeneland July Sales, was a stakes winner of four races in France; he earned nearly one million francs while campaigning at two, three and four. Retired to stud in 1994, his first crop are weanlings of 1995. Northern Park cumulative fertility rate for his first two seasons at stud is 98 percent; he will stand at Gainesway for a fee of \$5,000, guaranteed live foal, payable September 1 of the year bred.

LAGUNA SECA RETIRED Stakes winner Laguna Seca (Seattle Slew), winner of the Arbor Vitae S. at Hollywood in July and a graded-stakes placed earner of \$131,330, has been retired and has shipped to Denali Stud in Paris, Kentucky for the 1996 breeding season. A daughter of graded stakes-winner Topicount, the three-year-old is expected to be bred to Mr. Prospector.
