JEUNE TOPS MELBOURNE CUP ENTRIES Jeune (GB) (Kalaglow {Ire}), winner of the event in 1994 and the 1995 Horse of the Year in Australia, tops the list of 23 runners set for Monday's \$1.5 million Melbourne Cup in Australia. The six-year-old, who began his career in England where he was a Group winner at three and four, shipped Down Under at the end of his 1993 campaign and has enjoyed great success in his new country. A two-time G1 winner in Australia last year, Jeune has notched two more this year; he has also been second in four '95 G1 stakes. The P. C. Haves trainee carries 130 pounds. High weight for the race is the European import Double Trigger (Ire) (Ela-Mana-Mou (Ire)) at 133 pounds. The four-year-old colt has won five of seven starts this year, including the G1 Gold Cup at Royal Ascot in July; he finished fourth in the Prix du Cadran at Longchamp going two-and-a-half miles in his last start September 30. Vintage Crop (Ire) (Rousillon), the 1993 Melbourne Cup victor, returns for another try. The eightyear-old, seventh in last year's edition, has taken three of his five starts this year; he was also fourth last time out in the G1 Jefferson Smurfit Memorial Irish St. Leger, a race he won in 1993 and 1994. ALWOW PROBABLE FOR YELLOW RIBBON

Last year's Canadian Horse of the Year Alywow (Alysheba), winner of the GIC Canadian Maturity by 13 lengths in her last start, is likely to ship to California for next Sunday's GI Yellow Ribbon Invitational at Santa Anita. The four-year-old filly ended her 1994 campaign with a trip to Hollywood for the GI Matriarch, but finished seventh as the 2-1 favorite and came out of the race with a condylar fracture of the left hind cannon bone which kept her on the shelf for eight months. "She has had four good races since coming back from the injury and she should be fit," said her trainer, Roger Attfield, who added he would discuss the decision with her owner, David Willmot, this weekend before making a final commitment to ship.

The Thoroughbred Owners of California yesterday presented a two-part proposal which it hopes will strengthen the current California Thoroughbred Breeders' Association Incentive Awards program. The first part of the proposal calls for a dramatic increase in Calbred owner awards, while the second centers on a new stallion incentive program. The suggested Stallion Incentives Awards program, which would cost approximately \$6 million per year, would look to attract between 10 and 15 new stallions, with stud fees of between \$10,000 and \$50,000, to California during each three-year cycle.

Local News: Bay Meadows

Due to a mishap at the start of Friday night's second race at Bay Meadows, Billy Rae J (Chester J.) and Forty'n Fabulous (Inherent Star) were both declared nonstarters by the track stewards.
