CARNEGIE TO JAPAN Carnegie (Ire) (Sadler's Wells), winner of the 1994 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe at Longchamp and third last time out in the Breeders' Cup Turf, has been retired to stand at a Japanese stud. The colt will remain the property of his owner Sheikh Mohammed's Darley Stud Management Company. But his career as a stallion, with a covering fee of approximately \$45,000, is due to begin at Japan's JS Company Stud in 1996. A statement issued during the weekend by Darley's Newmarket, England office said, "The decision to stand Carnegie in Japan demonstrates once again the importance Sheikh Mohammed attaches to Japan in the international racing and breeding context."

CRIMSON PUT DOWN Crimson (Alleged), the 8-5 favorite in Saturday's Discovery Handicap at Aqueduct, was humanely destroyed after fracturing both right front sesamoids during the race. The horse had been riding a four-race winning streak and was considered one of the more promising new faces in the three-year-old division. "They were shattered," said trainer Angel Penna Jr. "It was like a broken windshield. We put him down about an hour and a half after the race. We took x-rays and saw that there was a very slim chance that we could save him. It would have been a very painful process. Whenever you have to put one down, it's a very difficult decision, but sometimes it is best for the horse. He was really a very nice horse." Owned by Lazy F Ranch, Crimson broke down on the first turn of the ninefurlong race. His only loss had come in his career debut, when third in a maiden race at Gulfstream. He was making his stakes debut in the Discovery.

CUT THE CHARM RETIRED Kathy Jo Stable's Cut the Charm (Cutlass) has been retired from racing. The four-year-old filly, winner of eight of 22 starts for earnings of \$600,962, won seven stakes from ages two to four including the \$400,000 My Dear Girl S. at Calder and the GIII Davona Dale S. at Gulfstream. "She just isn't training the way I'd like her to," trainer Jim Bracken reported. "There isn't any serious injury or anything, but she has been too good to us to risk her any further when she's not doing well. She'll go to Kentucky and hopefully will be bred to either Deputy Minister or Seattle Slew in the spring."


