KEENELAND DAY TWO: USER FRIENDLY BRINGS \$2.5 MILLION User

Friendly (GB) (Slip Anchor {GB}), the top filly in Europe at three and winner of both the Epsom and the Irish Oaks, brought a bid of \$2.5 million to top yesterday's second session of Keeneland's 1995 November Breeding Stock Sale. The now six-year-old, believed in foal to Mr. Prospector, was consigned by Taylor Made Sales Agency, Agent XVIII; she was purchased by Kazuo Nakamura. Aki Kato, agent for Mr. Nakamura, who stands Breeders' Cup Classic winner Arcangues in Japan, said, "She's one of a kind. It's hard to find." The second-highest price Sunday was paid for Salchow (Nijinsky II), an unraced five-year-old consigned by Lane's End, agent, who produced her first foal, a colt by Mr. Prospector, this year. In foal to Woodman, the halfsister to champions Machiavellian and Coup de Genie was sold for \$1,250,000; although Josh Collins of B.B.A. (England) signed the ticket, the purchase was reported to be a buy-back for her original owner. The top weanling Sunday was a daughter of Mr. Prospector out of Embellished (Seattle Slew). Consigned by John R. Gaines Thoroughbreds, agent, the half-sister to MGSW Seattle Dawn (*Grey Dawn II) was purchased for \$650,000 by B.B.A. (England). "I thought she was a beautiful filly," said Josh Collins. "The way the mare trade is here today, if she never saw a race course, you could bring her back here and get all your money back." A total of 276 horses sold at Keeneland Sunday, bringing in \$40,438,500, an average of \$146,516. (Top five broodmares and weanlings, p2)

WOODBINE CANCELS SUNDAY The 10-race program at Ontario's Woodbine was called off Sunday after the jockeys refused to ride on the frozen racetrack. The strip froze after a late-morning snowstorm hit the Toronto area. The track should be ready for Wednesday's card, provided the severe weather does not continue; plans for rescheduling Sunday's feature, the GIIIC Autumn H., have not yet been decided.

Alpride, the top two-year-old filly in Italy and a Group winner at two and three in that country, made her American debut in July and bested Possibly Perfect in the GI Beverly Hills H. The bay finished behind that filly in her two subsequent starts but found the winner's circle once again when her nemesis was scratched, racing off the flank of Bold Ruritana to the stretch, then wresting the lead from that rival and digging down deep to hold off French import Angel In My Heart for the victory. "She couldn't have been coming up to this race any better," said jockey Chris McCarron. "She had filled out, just looked sensational; I was optimistic even before Possibly Perfect scratched." Explaining how he came to buy the filly, trainer Ron McAnally said, "French agent Emmanuel de Seroux was at the last Breeders' Cup at Churchill Downs, and I asked him if he knew of anything in Europe worth looking at. This filly was one, and, believe it or not, the other one was Northern Spur. When (Alpride) came on the market. I flew over to see her. We tried to negotiate with her previous owner, but he wouldn't budge an inch. So, we wound up giving him the bucks." McAnally added that a rematch with Possibly Perfect in the Matriarch is a possibility.

HILL FARM D'Hallevant (Ogygian), a multiple graded-stakes winner of \$515,350, and GISP winner Whitney Tower (Storm Bird) will both stand their first seasons at stud in 1996 at Rising Hill Farm in Ocala, Florida. Five-year-old D'Hallevant, winner of the GIII Palos Verdes H. in 1995 and a stakes-record setter in the '94 GIII Pat O'Brien Breeders' Cup H., was retired after finishing fourth in the Bay Meadows Budweiser Breeders' Cup H. September 16. He will stand for a fee of \$3,000, live foal. Four-year-old Whitney Tower, third to champion Dehere in the GII Saratoga Special and the GI Hopeful at two, will stand for a fee of \$2,500, live foal.

"RED SMITH" WINNERS ANNOUNCED Four journalists have been recognized by Churchill Downs for their outstanding coverage of the 1995 "Run for the Roses" in the 13th annual Red Smith Kentucky Derby Writing Contest. Blackie Sherrod of the Dallas Morning News earned his first Red Smith award in the Advance category. Chuck Culpepper of the Lexington Herald-Leader received his second consecutive Red Smith award in the Sunday Wrap-Up category. Saturday's on-track attendance at Santa Anita, 34,220, was a season-high; the total handle of \$16,289,956 was a Cal Cup record.

The California Horse Racing Board Friday approved the amended application for Santa Anita's December 26, 1995 to April 22, 1996 meet, allowing the track to delete two Wednesday programs, January 17 and February 21; the Board also approved eight-race cards on some weekdays and 10-race cards on some weekends.

The Santa Anita Foundation will distribute \$534,500, proceeds from charity-day racing, to 41 beneficiaries, including \$250,000 to the United Way and \$100,000 to the Methodist Hospital Foundation. The Oak Tree Charity Foundation will distribute \$116,000 to 36 charities.
