#### ANOTHER MILLION-DOLLAR MARE AT

KEENELAND Becoming the fifth mare to top the \$1 million mark at Keeneland's 1995 November Breeding Stock Sale, Dance With Grace (Mr. Prospector), a stakes winner expecting her first foal next year, attracted a bid of \$1,450,000 to top yesterday's session. Believed in foal to Devil's Bag, the four-year-old was consigned by Bluegrass Thoroughbred Services Inc.. Agent II; she was purchased by Wertheimer et Frere. "She's going to stay in Kentucky," said Alec Head, advisor to the Wertheimers. "She'll most likely go to Danzig. We liked everything about her--her looks and her pedigree. It's very difficult to judge what a horse will go for in this market. It's a very strong market. I thought she could have brought anything from \$850,000 to \$1.5 million." Strategic Maneuver (Cryptoclearance), a multiple Grade I winner in foal to Danzig, brought the second-highest bid Monday; the four-year-old, consigned by Eaton Sales, agent, went for \$800,000 to Elizabeth Moran's Brushwood Stable. "She's young and she's very handsome and she's in foal to the best stallion there is," said Moran. "She went for what I thought she was going to bring. I haven't really made definite plans, but we'll probably send her back to Danzig again." A filly by Nureyev--Allegretta (GB) (Lombard) brought the highest price for a weanling yesterday. Consigned by Denali Stud, Agent VIII, the half-sister to Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe winner Urban Sea (Miswaki) went for a bid of \$600,000 to Shadwell Estate Co. Ltd. A total of 301 horses sold for \$33,237,500 Monday, an average of \$110,424; one share in Silver Hawk went for \$220,000. (Top broodmares and weanlings, p2)

HAWTHORNE CANCELS AFTER FIRST Hawthorne Race Course, which had to call of Saturday's card due to severe weather, cancelled again yesterday after running the first race. Both management and jockeys agreed that the track, labelled sloppy, was unsafe. Racing is scheduled to resume Wednesday.

Returning from the short break, the six-year-old saved ground to the far turn, then found room between horses to get the lead in midstretch and draw clear. "I've been working this horse, so I know him pretty well. I was very fortunate that he relaxed really good like I wanted him to," said winning rider Alex Solis. "We got through on the inside in the stretch...finally, it opened up and I went through. I had a lot of horse, and he came through." It was the Irish-bred's third win since being claimed for \$100,000 in May. Favored Patio de Naranjos (Chi), up with the leaders early, dropped back on the backstretch but finished well to gain the place.

### LONESOME GLORY TAKES COLONIAL CUP

Making a bid for his third Eclipse Award, two-time steeplechase champion Lonesome Glory (Transworld) ran away from eight rivals to take his second straight \$100,000 Colonial Cup at Camden, South Carolina Sunday, Owned by Kay Jeffords and trained by Bruce Miller, the seven-year-old surged toward the lead with four fences left, passing pacesetter Victorian Hill (Dickens Hill {Ire}) at the second-last and holding off Rowdy Irishman (Erins Isle {Ire}) to win it by a length and a quarter; Mistico (Chi) (Balconaje (Arg) was along for third. Said winning rider Blythe Miller, "He sure seems to do everything right. When we got to the front he pricked his ears and I had to say 'Come on, Lonesome, we've got another fence to jump'." The win secured seasonal money-won honors for Lonesome Glory, who earned \$214,680 in 1995. He becomes the second steeplechaser to pass \$500,000 in earnings. Plans call for the jumper to campaign in England this winter.

### GAL IN A RUCKUS PREVAILS IN CANADIAN

OAKS DECISION The Ontario Racing Commission has ruled that the original results of the Canadian Oaks, run June 18 at Woodbine, will stand, making Gal In A Ruckus (Bold Ruckus) the official winner. An appeal filed by Michael Doyle on behalf of Frank Stronach, owner of the third-place finisher Honky Tonk Tune (Cure the Blues), was denied. Stronach was appealing the decision of the stewards, who disallowed a claim of foul by Honky Tonk Tune's rider, Sandy Hawley, against jockeys Herb McCauley, aboard the winner, and Jim McAleney, riding runner-up Kathie's Colleen (Woodman), for an incident which occurred near the quarter pole in that race. Ontario Racing Commission Chairman Stanley Sadinsky and Commissioners Herb McGirr and Stephen Edwards deliberated for less than 10 minutes after reviewing films of the race and hearing testimony from all parties; they concluded that while there may have been some interference with Honky Tonk Tune, it was impossible to determine who caused the interference and to what degree it may have affected the outcome of the race.
