### **TWO MARES TOP \$1 MILLION AT**

**KEENELAND** Two broodmares, both in foal to Seeking the Gold, brought bids of more than \$1 million during the opening session of Keeneland's 1995 November Breeding Stock Sale, which began vesterday in Lexington. The session topper was the fivevear-old mare Vee See Are (Devil's Bag), a half-sister to GISW Scan (Mr. Prospector) who has produced two foals, including a 1994 yearling; consigned by Claiborne Farm and Nicole Perry Gorman as part of their breeding stock reduction, she sold for \$1.4 million to Pegasus Bloodstock USA, agent for Himukai Farm of Japan. Gana Facil (\*Le Fabuleux), part of the Frances A. Genter dispersal consigned by Gainesway Farm as agent, brought the second-highest bid of \$1,350,000; the 14-year-old, dam of champion Unbridled, winner of the Kentucky Derby and Breeders' Cup Classic, and GISW Cahill Road, was purchased by John Magnier. "We bought her for a partnership, but we haven't figured it all out," said Magnier. "We don't vet know what the make-up will be. She'll go to Thunder Gulch. I thought that she might fit, because she has done well with that line." The highest price for a weanling at the Keeneland opener came in for a daughter of Capote out of MGISW Tappiano (Fappiano). The bay, also part of the Genter dispersal, was purchased for \$600,000 by Demi O'Byrne, agent for a John Magnier/Michael Tabor partnership. O'Byrne indicated that the filly would remain in America to race. The Genter Stable sold a total of 53 horses for \$7,841,000, an average of \$147,943. In all, including the Genter dispersal, 185 hips were sold during Keeneland's first session, grossing \$22,864,200. The average for the opener was \$123,590; the median price was \$55,000. The Keeneland November Breeding Stock Sale continues through November 21.

STORMY WEATHER CANCELS CARDS Saturday's card at Illinois' Hawthorne Race Course was called off due to severe weather which left the track unsafe for racing. Heavy rains in the area Friday were followed by a deep freeze and snow, but crews working through the day yesterday were able to get the track back in shape, and racing is expected to resume today. It has not yet been decided when, or if, Saturday's feature race, the Illinois Silent Beauty S., will be rescheduled. Racing at Beulah Park, The Meadowlands and Penn National was also cancelled Saturday due to the bad weather.

#### FOXFIELD MARES TOP FASIG-TIPTON

SELECT S'Nice (Riverman), dam of GISW Vaudeville (Theatrical {Ire}) and in foal once again to that stallion, brought a bid of \$520,000 to top the second session of the Fasig-Tipton Selected Fall Mixed sale, held last night. The 11-year-old, part of the Foxfield consignment, was purchased by Narvick International. The evening's second-highest price was paid for Foxfield's Scoot (Mr. Prospector), in foal to Dayjur, who went to Norio Sakurai for a bid of \$350,000. A total of 97 horses went through the ring Saturday, bringing in \$4,720,700 for an average of \$48,667. Adding Friday night's weanling results, the Selected sale saw 162 hips sold for \$6,725,700, an average of \$41,517. While the gross was up nearly 21 percent from 1994, when 102 head sold for \$5,564,000, the average dropped nearly 24 percent, from \$54,549 a year ago.

### CHRB APPROVES NORTHERN CALIFORNIA

CALENDAR The California Horse Racing Board approved a 1996 racing calendar Friday that leaves the fair schedules largely intact while redistributing the northern California Thoroughbred dates to reduce the overlap with fair meetings. When the meets do overlap, efforts will be made by both the fairs and the major associations to operate on the same days and to close when no intrastate simulcast signal is available, generally on Tuesdays. The Los Angeles County Fair meet will give up two Tuesdays of racing in exchange for one extra Monday on which Bay Meadows will be open for an exchange of signals. "We are trying to build the strongest possible racing circuit for all of California, and that requires a meld between the fairs and the major tracks in the north and south," said CHRB Vice Chairman Donald Valpredo, who co-chairs the Racing Dates Committee. As approved, the 1996 calendar has racing at Bay Meadows from January 24-March 24, and at Golden Gate Fields from March 27-June 16, followed by a gap for fair racing. Racing will resume at Bay Meadows August 30-November 4, then return to Golden Gate from November 6-December 22. The southern California schedules, similar to the 1995 dates, were approved at an earlier meeting.
