FLORIDA PARI-MUTUELS AT IMPASSE Florida's pari-mutuel industry may have lost one of its biggest supports after a less-than-productive meeting yesterday at Calder. After the meeting, Florida Congressman Steve Geller (D-Hallandale), chairman of the Regulated Industries committee which oversees the pari-mutuel industry, said, "I've done my level best to bring the leaders of the pari-mutuel industry together, and they just don't seem to want to cooperate." Attending the session, which was called by Geller, were Calder President Ken Dunn, Gulfstream Park President Doug Donn, Florida Thoroughbred Breeders' and Owners' Association President Stanley Ersoff and Florida Horsemen's Benevolent and Protective Association President Scott Savin and Executive Director Kent Stirling. "Every time I offered a suggestion, someone in the group would find a reason why it wouldn't work," said a frustrated Geller. "Everybody wants simulcasting, but to get it the dog industry wants card rooms. The Thoroughbred tracks say they want card rooms, but only if they can operate at night and take simulcast after 7 p.m. (the time when live Thoroughbred racing must be completed). The breeders are afraid of card rooms but want phone wagering. The dogs and jai-alai don't want phone betting. The one thing I learned from this meeting is that I'll be able to spend more time with my family over the holidays, rather than running off to unproductive meetings over pari-mutuels."

He had been running with better, and I thought he was the best horse in the race. He proved it today." The runner-up was placed last for causing interference in the stretch.
