Consigned by Blackburn Farm, agent, the chestnut filly is the first foal from a half-sister to GISW Dixie Brass. In all, a total of 258 horses sold for \$4,088,300 at Keeneland yesterday, an average of \$15,846. The median price for the session was \$12,250. Through nine days of the 11-day auction, 2.410 hips have been sold for \$137,861,500, an average of \$57,204. The sale continues through Tuesday.

### **REMINGTON ANNOUNCES 1996 SPRING**

STAKES SCHEDULE Director of Racing and Racing Secretary Mike Anifantis has unveiled Remington Park's 1996 Spring Meeting stakes program, a line-up that includes 20 added-money and 13 overnight stakes. The \$300,000g Remington Park Derby highlights the schedule; it will be run March 23, two weeks earlier than in the past. The \$100,000 Great West S. March 2 will serve as the major Remington Park Derby prep. Also set for the meet is the \$150,000 Budweiser Breeders' Cup on the grass April 13 and the \$75,000 Silver Bullet Centennial H. for sprinters March 16. The Remington spring meet begins February 3 and runs through May 5.
