Lassigny came out after bruising his right front hoof earlier this week. Said his trainer, Bill Mott, "He is still sore and we have decided to withdraw. He will be fine in around 10 days and, after coming so far, we are disappointed not to be running. But Lassigny's bruising will not be helped by the race, so he misses the Cup." Turk Passer injured the suspensory ligament in his left front leg, but trainer Scotty Schulhofer said the injury did not appear career-threatening. "He will recover in time, and I hope we will be able to be invited to the Japan Cup again next year," said Schulhofer.

ONLY ROYALE RETIRED Only Royale (Caerleon), dual winner of the G1 Yorkshire Oaks, has been retired and will leave trainer Luca Cumani's Newmarket yard next week to travel to owner Frank Stronach's farm in Kentucky. She is scheduled to be bred to Holy Bull. The six-year-old, who amassed nearly \$600,000 in earnings during her racing career, also captured the G2 Jockey Club S. at Newmarket and the G3 Prix Foy at Longchamp. Said Cumani, "She was a wonderfully enthusiastic racemare and a joy to train. I will be sad to see her leave."



The family of John Sikura, a prominent Thoroughbred owner and breeder who was killed a year ago in a car fire on his Toronto farm, is suing General Motors for \$120 million. Sikura, 60, died last November 25 when he was trapped inside his 1994 Cadillac Seville, which had caught fire. A report by the Toronto metro police department apparently indicated that an electrical malfunction in the car's engine caused the tragedy. The Ontario coroner's office has recently notified Sikura's family of the results of their investigation into the case, which will be made public next week. The lawsuit, which was filed Wednesday in the Covington, Kentucky district court, seeks \$40 million in compensatory damages and \$80 million in punitive damages.
