TURFWAY OPENS TODAY With its \$5 million renovation recently completed. Turfway Park opens a new season of racing this afternoon. First post is set for 7:00 p.m. Wednesdays through Fridays and 1:30 p.m. Saturdays and Sundays; the weekend post time moves to 1:00 p.m. starting with a special Tuesday afternoon card December 26. Seeking her sixth 1995 stakes victory, Cat Appeal (Storm Cat) heads a full field of fillies and mares in the opening day \$75,000 Holiday Inaugural S. going six furlongs. The threevear-old is trained by D. Wayne Lukas, who will keep a string of 40 horses at the Florence, Kentucky track during the Holiday Meet for the first time. "We are approaching the new racing season with enthusiasm and optimism," said Mark Simendinger, Turfway's president. "Last fall, we completed a new entrance for our fans and a remodeled paddock area for our horses and horsemen. Without question, we are looking forward to one of our best racing seasons ever." The Holiday Meet runs through December 31; Turfway's Winter-Spring Meet, highlighted by the \$600,000 Jim Beam S. March 30, runs January 1 through April 4.

ISRAEL COHEN DEAD Israel Cohen, prominent Thoroughbred owner and the chairman of Giant Food Inc. the largest grocery store chain in the U.S., died Wednesday night at his home in Northwest Washington D.C. after a long illness. He was 83. A native of Palestine, Cohen immigrated to America at the age of nine, where his father, Nehemiah, started the family company with three butcher shops in Pennsylvania. The first Giant Food store opened in 1936. A longtime horse owner on the Maryland circuit, Cohen built his own barn at Laurel in 1989; he raced such stakes winners as Mighty Appealing (Valid Appeal), Montbrook (Buckaroo), Speakerphone (Fappiano), Prince Valiant (Stage Door Johnny), American Artist (Valid Appeal) and Mixed Appeal (Mighty Appealing). The Cohen stable of 18 horses will be sold at the Fasig-Tipton Mixed Sale at Timonium, Maryland December 4. A memorial service will be held this Wednesday at 2:00 p.m. at Martin's Crosswinds in Greenbelt.

Sent off at 16-1 despite an alibi in his last, the colt sprinted for the early lead, was passed at the 3/4 pole, but recaptured the lead at the 1/16th pole and then was all out to hold off Wekiva Springs. "This is a big one," said trainer Jimmy Toner. "That was exciting. Last time out he swung his head back when the gate opened and that cost him. I schooled him in the gate since then, but today he acted up in the paddock and I couldn't get the saddle on him. He's going to give you trouble somewhere. He's just a big old stupid kid...but once he's in the race, it's a different ballgame." Agreed winning jockey Robbie Davis, "He's a beast...but once you get on him, he feels so good--he always feels good." The 5-2 favorite UNACCOUNTED FOR (Private Account) finished an even fifth and, according to trainer Scotty Schulhofer, will be retired from racing to stand at stud in 1996.


