TOTAL HANDLE SOARS AT CHURCHILL DOWNS FALL MEET A record \$122,636,191 was wagered on Churchill Downs races, including on-track, state-wide and at 56 primary sites and their 428 satellite affiliates throughout the U.S. and Canada, during the track's 24-day Fall Meet which ended Saturday, November 25. This represents an increase of 54 percent in total wagering over 1994. Average daily wagering on Churchill Downs was \$5,109,841. "We recognized the opportunity to diversify our markets by exporting Churchill Downs races throughout North America," said Thomas H. Meeker, track president and chief executive officer, "While we realize a smaller profit on a dollar wagered off-track, the phenomenal increase in total handle has allowed Churchill Downs to increase purses and track revenues. Additionally, we have become less dependent on our primary market as a major source of revenue." Average daily handle on-track totaled \$1,202,980, with on-track attendance at 8,160, representing declines of six percent and eight percent respectively. However, purse levels soared to a fall record average of \$322,000 per day, attracting full fields with an average of 9.8 starters per race. "We presented the highest quality racing in the history of Churchill Downs," Meeker said. "It was gratifying to see our customers respond in record levels to the superior racing, wagering and entertainment product that our horsemen and staff delivered on a regular basis." Jockey Shane Sellers took the riding title with 30 wins; Bernard Flint led all trainers with 14 victories; and John Franks led the owners standings with seven wins.

HOLLYWOOD TURF FESTIVAL A SUCCESS

Hollywood Park's Turf Festival concluded Sunday with an Autumn Meeting record single-day handle of \$12,487,362, excluding the 1987 Breeders' Cup day. The three-day festival attracted 41,097 patrons on-site, representing a 15.7 percent increase over last year. The total wagered over the long weekend was \$36,304,259, representing a 16.4 percent increase.

New York shipper Duda, winless in four stakes tries since taking the GII Sheepshead Bay H. at Belmont June 4, most recently finished fourth, beaten 17½-lengths, in the GII Long Island H. over the soft Belmont turf Oct. 29. Back on firm ground here, the dark bay raced well back in the 14-horse field early through slow fractions of :24 4/5, :49 3/5 and 1:13 2/5. She was then angled outside on the second turn, and in the stretch blew by the field down the center of the track to win going away. "This was a complete surprise," said winning jockey Jerry Bailey. "I always knew (Duda) was a nice mare, but she hadn't been running all that great. But she'd been running on soft turf, so that was a question mark. I had a great trip. I saved ground all the way until the middle of the turn. Then I kind of eased out around three or four of them, and she made her run." French invader Angel In My Heart, 2nd in the GI Yellow Ribbon Nov. 12 in her North American debut, secured the place spot once again. MGI winner Wandesta finished third in the Matriarch for the second straight year. 2-1 race favorite ALPRIDE (IRE) (Alzao), ½-length winner of the Yellow Ribbon in her last, raced with the leaders into the top of the stretch but failed to launch a late bid, finishing seventh. "I guess two races in 14 days was too much racing," said Alpride's trainer Ron McAnally. "She'll get a break now. The plan is to continue racing next year."

Drysdale added, "He worked very well coming into this race. We added some little blinkers--little cheater blinkers. It appeared in France he had been just hanging a bit." 3-1 second choice Da Hoss, back on the turn after finishing 13th and last in the Oct. 28 Breeders' Cup Sprint, had traffic problems on the turn for home but finished well to be third.

TEST MATCH HOPING FOR TV COVERAGE Gosforth Park, the South African racecourse planning to stage an "International Jockeys' Test Match" February 17, 1996, is currently negotiating with several TV companies in a bid to have the event shown on screens in Britain. James Goodman, employed by Gosforth Park's Turf Club to organize a series of four races in which teams from Europe and South Africa will be in opposition, said, "We believe it would be very popular with British viewers. We have put two strong sides together and hope to make every contest a genuine test of jockeyship by ensuring all the horses are of similar ability." The Test Match, in which Europe is set to be represented by Cash Asmussen, Willie Carson, Frankie Dettori, Pat Eddery and Michael Kinane, will be decided on the basis of a quartet of races. Points (ten for a win down to one for a last place) will be allotted to each rider's every mount and the events will be run over distances from five furlongs to 1½-miles. Godoman, who has enlisted Felix Coetzee, Jeff Lloyd, Basic Marcus, Michael Roberts and Pierre Strydom for South Africa's home team, added: "We would love it to become an annual affair - something like racing's equivalent of the Ryder Cup - and we are on the look-out for sponsors to help us towards achieving that end."
