CANADIAN RACES LOSE SPONSORSHIP

Woodbine officials intend to preserve the prestige of the two international Grade I races on their schedule despite notification that both Molson Breweries and Rothmans Limited have withdrawn their sponsorship of the races. In a statement released vesterday, George Hendrie, chairman of the board of The Ontario Jockey Club, said, "It is our intention to carry on with these great Grade I races. These two races provide our fans with an opportunity to see the best horses in the world right here at Woodbine. With the Breeders' Cup coming to Woodbine in 1996...they'll afford horsemen an opportunity to ship horses in early to prep for racing's Day of Champions." Molson Breweries has sponsored the Molson Export Million since the event's inception in 1988; the threeyear-old fixture was granted Grade I status for the first time in 1994. Originally known as the Canadian International Championship, the Rothmans Ltd. International was inaugurated in 1981; it has become one of the most important grass races in North America. Both races were worth \$1 million (Canadian); money for the purses now would have to come from the OJC's Thoroughbred marketing budget until new corporate sponsors can be enlisted. "And we are actively seeking sponsorship liaisons," said Hendrie. It is expected that the Molson Export Million will become the Woodbine Million, and the Rothmans Ltd. International will revert to its former name, the Canadian International.

SHREWD IDEA TO THE U.S. Shrewd Idea (Alleged), runner-up to Sunshack in the G1 Prix Royal Oak going a 1 15/16 miles October 22 at Longchamp, has been purchased by Gary and Mary West and is scheduled to arrive in California in time for next Sunday's Gl Hollyood Turf Cup. The five-year-old, a Group 2 winner while racing in England, France, Germany, Ireland and Italy, is expected from France Monday. "I've never seen him, but he's supposedly a medium-sized horse and, obviously, distance appears to be his game," said new trainer Randy Bradshaw, who added that bloodstock agent Hubert Guy negotiated the Shrewd Idea deal.

The five-year-old makes her fifth start and looks for her first win since returning from a year's layoff in August. The British-bred mare, three-for-five at Hollywood, picked up a pair of Grade II events over the track in the spring of '94. Urbane (Citidancer), never off the board in eight career starts, missed beating Serena's Song by a lip in the GI Hollywood Starlet a year ago; she comes into this race off a powerful performance dusting Maryland-breds in the Maryland Million Oaks October 14. Twice The Vice (Vice Regent) has finished first or second in six of nine outings on the main track; the versatile four-year-old, a Grade I winner on turf and Grade III winner on dirt, returned from the bench after nine-and-a-half months and captured a Hollywood grass allowance November 15.

DAYJUR'S STUD FEE REDUCED According to a report in Saturday's *Daily Racing Form*, **Dayjur** (Danzig), who entered stud at Lexington's Shadwell Farm in 1991, will stand for \$30,000, live foal, in 1996. The eight-year-old, England's Horse of the Year in 1990, had originally stood for a fee of \$50,000; a Group 1 winner in England and France who narrowly missed taking the 1990 Gl Breeders' Cup Sprint when he jumped a shadow near the finish line, Dayjur has sired 25 winners and two stakes winners from his two crops to race.

RECORD HANDLE AT CALDER Yesterday's combined mutuel handle (on-track, inter-track and interstate) at Calder was an all-time record for the Tropical at Calder meet. TATTERSALLS WEANLING SALE CONCLUDES

A colt by Sadler's Wells--Zummerudd (Habitat) brought a bid of \$409,165 to top not only the final session but all five days of the 1995 Tattersalls' December Foal Sale at Newmarket. Consigned by Barronstown Stud, Ireland, the bay is a half-brother to General Monash (Thorn Dance), a G2 winner in France, and Furajet (The Minstrel), a stakes winner in England; he was purchased by Demi O'Byrne. A total of 197 lots sold on the final day of the auction, grossing \$7,027,250; the average Saturday was \$35,671. There was no comparable session last year. The Tattersalls' December Sale continues Monday with the first session of the Mares, Horses in and out of Training, and Stallions Sale.

NYTB ELECTS NEW BOARD The New York Thoroughbred Breeders, Inc. has announced the names of the 11 members who will serve as directors on its Board for 1996-97. Because only 11 members chose to submit petitions to be elected to the Board, NYTB by-laws allow for the membership election to be bypassed; secretary/treasurer Michael Flynn cast one vote for the 11 candidates on behalf of the membership at the final NYTB meeting of the 1994-95 Board, held December 1 in Albany. "The new Board was elected much in the same way others have been during the past 16 years," stated Dr. Douglas Koch, who served as president for 1994-95. "This was an orderly transition and the outgoing Board has utmost confidence in, and is enthusiastic about, those who will begin to serve in January." Five of the new directors will be serving on the NYTB Board for the first time; they are breeders Ronald J. Davis, Thomas J. Gallo III, Carl Lizza Jr., Karen A. Murphy and Gustave C. Schoenborn Jr. Remaining on the Board are Timothy Boyan, Barbara Brewer, Michael D. Flynn, Jill P. Rich, Louis M. Salerno and Philip J. Trowbridge. The new Board will meet in early January to elect officers for the 1996-97 term. The new president will also serve on the Board of the Breeding and Development Fund.


