#### JAPANESE RIDERS TOP SUPER JOCKEY

**SERIES** Celebrating the long-awaited reopening of Japan's Hanshin Race Course, which had been closed since the devastating Hanshin earthquake in January, Japanese riders nailed down the top four spots in the ninth "World Super Jockeys Series,' held Saturday and Sunday. Norihiro Yokoyama, the second-leading rider in Japan, captured the competition by winning three of the four races in the series; the 27-year-old had also won this year's "Young Jockeys World Championship" at Nakayama race course in March. Yutaka Take was second, with countrymen Katsumi Ando and Hitoshi Matoba third and fourth, respectively. Twelve jockeys from around the world competed in the event; completing the order of finish, they were Jim Collett (New Zealand), Thierry Jarnet (France), Kevin Darley (U.K.), Michael Kinane (Ireland), Darren Beadman (Australia), Mike Smith (U.S.), Anthony Cruz (Hong Kong) and Hiroshi Kawachi (Japan). In spite of colder-than-average weather, the series attracted a crowd of 37,400 Saturday, up 110 percent from a year ago, and 72,426 Sunday, up 124 percent from 1994. Total handle was \$90,138,599 the first day of the competition, and \$266,933,287 the second day.

MARE IN FOAL TO OPENING VERSE TOPS FASIG-TIPTON MIDLANTIC Into The Woods (Big Spruce), a seven-year-old broodmare in foal to freshman sire Opening Verse, brought a bid of \$26,000 to top the first session of Fasig-Tipton's Midlantic December Mixed Sale, held yesterday in Timonium, Maryland. Consigned by Charlton, agent, the full sister to MGSW Spruce Fir was purchased by Calverley Farm. A total of 199 horses were sold for \$715,900 during the opening day of the auction, which featured broodmares, broodmare prospects, stallions and stallion shares; the total was down 16.1 percent from 1994 when 193 head sold for \$853,600. The 1995 average, \$3,597, was down 18.6 percent from last year's average of \$4,423. The sale concludes today with an offering of weanlings, yearlings and horses of racing age, as well as the 25-horse Israel Cohen dispersal; bidding starts at 11:00 a.m.
