SLEW OF DAMASCUS INJURED Seven-year-old **Slew of Damascus** (Slewacide), who battled through the stretch with Lykatill Hil in Saturday's GIII \$100,000 William P. Kyne H. at Bay Meadows, came out of his game runner-up effort with a fracture in his right front leg. "He has a hairline crack in the cannon bone," reported trainer Craig Roberts Sunday morning. "We're looking at three months (of recovery time). We're not going to operate; these things repair themselves. He'll stay right here (in Roberts' barn at Bay Meadows)." Even if the injury heals perfectly, Roberts admits he doesn't know if Slew of Damascus will be the same horse. "At his age, you don't know how strong a horse will come back, or how willing they'll be to come back," Roberts said. Slew of Damascus, winner of the GI \$750,000 Hollywood Gold Cup in 1994, has earned \$1,398,800 while collecting 15 wins, nine seconds and seven thirds in 44 starts. Purchased for \$175,000 over the summer at Barretts' Horses of Racing Age Sale by the partnership of Roberts, George Losh and David and Jill Heerensperger, the chestnut gelding has earned \$185,750 in seven starts for his new owners.

TIKKANEN RETIRED George Strawbridge's **Tikkanen** (Cozzene), seventh after a troubled trip as the 4-1 favorite in yesterday's GI Hollywood Turf Cup in the final race of his career, will now be flown to Japan, where he will stand the 1996 breeding season at JS Company's Arrow Stud. Arrangements to stand the four-year-old in Japan have been made through Narvick International. Tikkanen, who will remain the property of Mr. Strawbridge, started five times in the U.S. with two Grade I victories in last year's GI Breeders' Cup Turf at Churchill Downs and GI Turf Classic Invitational S. at Belmont. The gray, a half-brother to Irish Champion Stayer Turgeon (Caro {Ire}), was also a G2 winner in France and graded stakes-placed in both England and Germany. He retires with a record of four wins from 17 starts for earnings of \$1,585,103.

THISTLEDOWN CANCELS AFTER THIRD RACE Due to high winds and extremely cold temperatures, Thistledown near Cleveland, Ohio cancelled most of Sunday's live racing card. After the completion of the third race, officials called off the remaining five races to avoid potential injury to jockeys and horses in the cold weather. Also canceling Sunday's live racing card due to winter weather conditions was Philadelphia Park.

Royal Chariot, back-to-back winner of the Wickerr H. and GII Del Mar Invitational H. over the Del Mar turf in Aug. and Sept., most recently finished fourth in the GII Citation H. at 1 1/8-miles over Hollywood's turf course Nov. 25. Stretching out in distance here, the dark bay angled to the inside early and saved ground in behind the leaders, lacked room behind rivals leaving the final turn and into the stretch, split foes in upper stretch, gained the lead in midstretch, then inched clear in the final stages and held off the fast-closing Talloires for his first Grade I triumph. "I always felt he was a mile-and-a-half-horse," said winning trainer Eddie Gregson. "Of course, today he got a very good trip, and Alex (Solis) gave him a patient ride, which was exactly what he needed, and we got the money. I'm glad I didn't lose him for \$50,000, that's all I can say." Royal Chariot started against \$32,000 maiden claimers June 11, 1994 and against \$50,000 maiden claimers in his next start July 10, 1994.

Southern California-based Ventiquattrofogli (Ire), winner of the GII Colonel F.W. Koester H. at Santa Anita Oct. 7, set the pace from the beginning, with Fujiyama Kenzan tracking him throughout. In the final furlong, the Japanese-bred took command to defeat his American-based rival by 3/4-length. In addition to earning nearly \$450,000 for his victory here, Fujiyama Kenzan will receive a \$675,000 bonus from the Japan Racing Association, paid to any Japanese-bred horse who wins in Graded/Group competition outside Japan.

Attendance at Sha Tin Racecourse for the day's events was 62,126, slightly less than the 68,981 who attended last year. Another 10,758 were at Happy Valley racetrack for a simulcast of the races, making the day's total attendance 72,884., down from 80,471 in 1994. HOLLYWOOD PARK IMPLODES HOTEL; MAKES WAY FOR FOOTBALL STADIUM

Hollywood Park yesterday imploded the Park Plaza Hotel (formerly Airport Park Hotel) in Inglewood, California to signify its progress in bringing professional football back to the greater Los Angeles metropolitan area. State and local public officials joined R.D. Hubbard, Hollywood Park chairman and CEO, in watching as a remote-controlled football hit the side of the Park Plaza Hotel as the hotel simultaneously imploded. This event paves the way for Hollywood Park to proceed with its proposed stadium development. Groundbreaking ceremonies could take place as early as April 1996, and the stadium could be constructed and fully operational by opening day of the 1998 football season. "This is another stepping-stone in our drive to bring the NFL back to the greater Los Angeles community," explained Hubbard. "We hope this implosion reverberates throughout the NFL, validating our serious commitment to securing a professional football team." Earlier this past week, the Inglewood City Planning Commission approved the final Environmental Impact Report for a football stadium to be built on Hollywood Park's property adjacent to the existing race track. Hollywood also recently unveiled renderings of its proposed \$250 million state-of-the-art stadium. The Park Plaza Hotel, built in 1973, closed Nov. 14, 1991 and had remained unoccupied ever since. It took an estimated 11 seconds for the hotel to collapse.

In other Futurity developments Sunday, **Ayrton S** (Polish Numbers) drilled six furlongs in a bullet 1:12 3/5 at Santa Anita, and **Exetera** (Forty Niner) worked seven furlongs in 1:29, also at Santa Anita.

California Cup Juvenile Fillies winner **Wheatly Special** (Wheatly Hall) breezed six furlongs over Hollywood's turf course yesterday in 1:16 1/5 (firm/dogs up) for trainer Jack Van Berg. Early probables for the Starlet also include undefeated Maker's Mark S. winner **Advancing Star** (Soviet Star), Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies runner-up **Cara Rafaela** (Quiet American) and maiden winner **Chile Chatte** (Storm Cat).

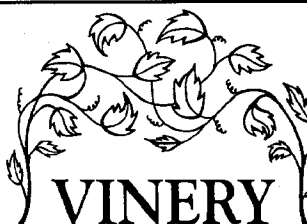
