RACING HALTED AT AQUEDUCT Racing was called off after the first race at Aqueduct yesterday when the jockeys refused to ride the remainder of the nine-race card. Rain checks were issued for clubhouse admission and parking, and fans who were at the track Saturday can trade in their Post Parade programs for a new edition any day through next Saturday. The Gll Ladies H. has been rescheduled for Wednesday and will be open to all original nominees; entries for Wednesday's card will be taken today.

GULFSTREAM GETS SIMULCAST HEARING

The First District Court of Appeal in Tallahassee has ruled that the state of Florida must give Gulfstream Park a hearing on whether or not it should be allowed to simulcast races in from out of state. In a case similar to Calder Race Course's, Judge Alexander H. Twedt said that the state had made an error in denying Gulfstream a hearing, and according to the judge, "...this case shall be afforded expedited treatment by this court." Gulfstream Park opens its winter meeting January 3; President Doug Donn said he would like to take in simulcasting signals as Calder is currently doing. Under a 90-day experiment granted by the state's Division of Pari-Mutuel Wagering, Calder is simulcasting two signals a day until December 29.

JAMES O'BRIEN PASSES AWAY

Thoroughbred owner and breeder James P. O'Brien died suddenly of a ruptured aorta Friday evening while visiting relatives in Ireland. He was 72. O'Brien, who lived in Plandome, Long Island and campaigned primarily on the New York and New Jersey circuits, owned his first horses in the early 1980's, forming the Jimtim Stable with partner Timothy Ahern in 1984. His first major stakes winner was **Mine Tonight** (Upper Nile); owned in partnership with Vivien Malloy, the filly produced stakes winner **Minetonightsfirst** (D'Accord) and multiple stakes-placed **Mine'spro** (Distinctive Pro) for the stable.

FROZEN TRACK CANCELS SUFFOLK CARD

Racing at Massachusetts' Suffolk Downs had to be called off for the second straight day Saturday due to the frozen track conditions. A Suffolk spokesman said it was hoped that racing could resume this afternoon. Yesterday's Norman Hall S. for Mass-bred two-year-olds will be rescheduled.

Cara Rafaela disappointed as the 6-5 choice in the Pocahontas S. at Churchill last time in a race that came just a week after her second-place finish in the Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies, but bounced back here, racing just off moderate fractions to the far turn, then launching a three-wide sweep that carried her past the pace-setting favorite Advancing Star in the final strides. Of the decision to run in the Pocahontas, trainer D. Wayne Lukas said, "We got her back to Kentucky and we could hardly keep her on the ground. She was just full of herself and feeling good. But I thought it was a misjudgement deluxe on my part. You either look very dumb or very smart in that situation." Commenting on the Starlet, winning jockey Corey Nakatani said, "I let her move up to them on the middle of the turn...she was going easy at the time, and we just kicked on. My filly gave me enough to win the race, and that was it." The runner-up just missed in her first start around two turns. "She ran her heart out, ran a great race," said trainer Richard Mandella. "The other filly was just a nose better. This was the big goal for the moment; now we'll just regroup."

Flag Down won the GII Red Smith H. at Aqueduct Nov. 18 in his last. Well back early here, he rallied between horses on the final turn and was forced four-wide into the stretch, then outfinished favorite Mecke, breaking the course record by a second and 1/5. "I plan to point him for the big grass races at Gulfstream this winter," said winning trainer Christophe Clement. "Of course, he is well-bred...if Mr. Paulson got a very good offer for him (as a stallion), I'm sure he would consider it." The runner-up finished well after weaving his way through traffic early; trainer Manny Tortora said he would look at races on dirt and turf for the colt.

CALDER HAS ANOTHER RECORD WEEKEND

For the third week in a row, handle records were broken at Calder Race Course. Saturday's combined mutuel handle of \$8,681,580 smashed last week's record of \$7,192,338. A crowd of 8,834 wagered \$1,548,176 on-track, while inter-track wagering sites contributed \$675,114, and inter-state wagering facilities handled \$6,256,422. Another record set last week fell. The total commingled pool on a single race reached an all-time high when \$1,206,345 was bet on the GII \$150,000 McKnight H.
