The four-year-old filly retired with a record of 14 wins from 17 starts and earnings of \$1,641,805; the Ogden Mills Phipps homebred has the edge over her stablemate Heavenly Prize (Seeking the Gold) for this year's older filly Eclipse Award after capping her '95 campaign with wins in the GI Ruffian, GI Spinster and her 13 1/2-length Breeders' Cup triumph. Heavenly Prize is currently prepping for an abbreviated 1996 campaign at Payson Park; trainer Shug McGaughey said the four-year-old will ship to Gulfstream after the first of the year and is expected to return to action in early February.

ADVANCING STAR SUFFERS SETBACK IN

STARLET Advancing Star (Soviet Star), who suffered the first defeat of her short career when second by a head in Saturday's GI Hollywood Starlet, came out of the race with a sore shin, but trainer Richard Mandella said he did not believe the situation was serious. "She didn't buck, it's just a tender shin," said Mandella. "I don't think we have that big a problem--she probably won't even be turned out. We'll just back off of her for a little while." If all goes well, the two-year-old filly will make her next start in the GI Las Virgenes at Santa Anita February 18.

WINTER WEATHER STOPS SUFFOLK COLD For the third straight day, racing had to be called off at Suffolk Downs due to unsafe track conditions caused by the inclement winter weather. The Boston area picked up another couple of inches of snow Saturday night, but Suffolk's track maintenance crew worked on the strip through the day Sunday and it is hoped that this afternoon's card will go off as planned.

Matty G came out of the gate last after an awkward start in the GIII Hollywood Prevue Breeders' Cup last time out, rushed up to set the pace for a half, then tired to finish fourth in that seven-furlong event. Enjoying a clean get-away this time, the longest shot on the board iumped out to a clear lead through a comfortable half in :46 3/5, shook off a challenge from TROPICOOL (Carr de Naskra), then went on about his business to post a decisive score under steady handling from iockey Alex Solis, shocking the crowd with a \$73.40 payoff. "I really wasn't surprised," said Solis. "This horse just wanted to route all along. He took the lead (at the top of the stretch) and I thought I better open up before everybody caught up with me. Nobody did." Remarked trainer Ron McAnally, "He had an infection in his throat and his lungs (at Del Mar)...he was in bad shape. We got up to Santa Anita and he got beat there; after that, we started treating him with antibiotics and it cleared up. That made all the difference." HENNESSY (Storm Cat), sent off at 1-5, broke a step slow, was steadied on the first turn and again on the second, stayed on the rail for the stretch drive and lacked a late kick. "It got a little rough for him on the first turn and he never settled into stride," said jockey Gary Stevens. "He was running very, very green down on the inside...he was ducking and bobbing. I couldn't get him close to the rail. I don't know--he's never reacted to anything like that before. When something happens like it did on the first turn, you're playing catch-up from the word 'Go.' You take a horse out of his style and you can forget about it."
