SANTAGATA IMPROVES Jockey Nick Santagata, injured in a spill at Aqueduct Friday, has had his condition upgraded to "stable but guarded." The 38year-old rider remains hospitalized at the North Shore Hospital in Manhasset, New York. According to Dr. Stephen J. O'Brien, director of the New York Racing Association's Emergency Medical Care Team, Santagata suffered a fractured sternum and multiple rib fractures. O'Brien speculated that Santagata could be out of action for three months. "The hospital has been flooded with calls," said a grateful Santagata. "Please thank everybody for their calls and concern, and a special thanks to the people in the ambulance who took me to the hospital."

BAY MEADOWS CANCELS After meeting with trainers and jockeys Saturday morning, Bay Meadows officials decided to cancel Saturday's card because of unsafe track conditions. Friday night's program was scrapped after the first race when the jockeys who rode the opener determined there were uneven spots on the track, which was labelled muddy. Track Superintendent Robert Turman said he was confident racing would resume Tuesday as scheduled, adding that he expected the track to be in "excellent condition" after the holiday break.

VIRGINIA HORSEMEN REACH AGREEMENT WITH COLONIAL DOWNS Colonial Downs, Virginia's first pari-miutuel racetrack which is scheduled to open its gates for its inaugural Thoroughbred meet in 1996, has reached an agreement with the Virginia Horsemen's Benevolent and Protective Association after a meeting between representatives of the two parties last week. The agreement is scheduled to go before the members of the Virginia HBPA January 11.
