WOLVERHAMPTON STAGES TWO MEETINGS

TODAY Britain's all-weather racetrack at Wolverhampton should break the freeze on racing in England today when it becomes the first track ever in the country to hold two meetings in one day. Originally scheduled to stage an evening floodlit meeting, Wolverhampton will now stage six races in the afternoon as well, giving race goers and punters 12 races in all on which to wager. Britain's big freeze has meant that no racing at all has taken place since December 21--23 scheduled meetings having been lost--and this has brought about a major loss in betting revenue to the industry at a time when it would normally have expected important turnover. After discussions with all interested parties, the British Horseracing Board has taken this decision to stage an extra all-weather meeting and owners and trainers have responded enthusiastically by making 115 entries for the 12 races. In the absence of racing in Britain, bookmakers have been taking bets on races in Ireland and from South Africa, with races being beamed "live" into most betting shops.

TIPICALLY IRISH SET FOR TROPICAL PARK

OAKS George Weaver, assistant to trainer D. Wayne Lukas, has confirmed that GISW **Tipically Irish** (Metfield) will make her next start in Monday's \$50,000 Tropical Park Oaks at Calder. The filly, winner of the GI Oak Leaf S. at Santa Anita in October, will be making her grass debut. "We're looking forward to running her on the turf," said Weaver. "She's got a big old foot on her and she's doing very well. I think she'll run a big one." The Michael Tabor colorbearer makes her first start since finishing sixth in the GII Demoiselle November 25 at Aqueduct; she was also sixth on a wet track in the Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies.

GULFSTREAM SIMULCAST TO NEW YORK

OTB Despite Thursday's pessimism, New York City Off Track Betting President Allie Sherman reported yesterday that an agreement in principle has been worked out with Gulfstream Park so that New York OTB will take the simulcasts from the upcoming Gulfstream meet. The agreement is expected to be signed shortly. Sherman had said that he did not believe the two parties could work out differences regarding the cost of the signal to New York OTB; he did not divulge the price OTB has now agreed to pay for the signal.

LABOR DISPUTE HALTS PHILLY RACING Rac-

ing was called off at Philadelphia Park Thursday and Friday after more than 200 employees of the track and its three off-track betting sites, including mutuel workers, Phone Bet personnel, and security, admissions and racing staff, went on strike. The employees, members of Local 137 of the AFL-CIO, have been working without a contract since November 1; the track reportedly is seeking to cut wages and pension benefits and to discontinue medical benefits. Negotiations between the union and track management continued yesterday. Racing could resume today, with replacement personnel working for the striking employees, if necessary.

NEW YORK BREEDING FUND ANNOUNCES

NEW BONUS PLAN In a Board meeting Thursday, the New York State Thoroughbred Breeding Fund approved a new award schedule which has been in development since the fall of 1993. The Fund agreed unanimously that, effective January 1, 1996 and starting with the foal crop of 1994, New York-bred and sired horses who finish in the top four in New York races will earn their breeders and owners an award of 20 percent of purses won; New York-breds by out-of-state sires will earn their owners and breeders a 10-percent bonus. The owners' awards are restricted to races with a minimum claiming price of \$35,000 through stakes races. Stallion awards for all horses will be 5 percent. There is a \$10,000 cap on all awards.
