FRENCH DEPUTY RETIRED Irving and Marjorie Cowan announced vesterday that French Deputy (Deputy Minister), winner of the '95 GII Jerome H. in the time of 1:33 2/5, is being retired and will stand stud at Three Chimneys Farm in Midway, Kentucky. Out of the GISW Mitterand, the three-year-old colt won four of his six career starts and earned \$195,200; he is being retired due to a tendon lesion. "French Deputy's Beyer Figure of 117 in the Jerome exceeded any other performance by a three-year-old of 1995 by several strides, and his mile was the fastest run this year at Belmont, said Robert Clay, owner of Three Chimneys. "He combines an impressive pedigree with speed, conformation and track performance, so he's an exciting addition to our stallion roster." The Kentucky-bred will stand as property of a partnership, with the Cowans retaining an interest. Plans call for the colt to be available for inspection at Three Chimneys during the January Sales.

BAY MEADOWS TRAINING TRACK SOLD The California Jockey Club, owners of Bay Meadows Race Course, has signed an agreement with lacocca and Associates, headed by former Chrysler Chairman Lee lacocca, to sell 40 of the nearly 178 acres that comprise the Bay Meadows facility. The land is currently used as a training track. According to James Conn, a director of the CJC, "The agreement is contingent upon the city granting entitlements which will allow (lacocca and Associates) to develop the property as they have requested. It will be some time before the transaction is completed; it normally takes at least a year."

FLORIDA FULL-CARD EXPERIMENT A

SUCCESS The 71 days of the full-card simulcasting experiment at Calder, once adjustment is made for 1995 business trends at participating pari-mutuel sites, resulted in an additional \$1,175,876 in purse money for horsemen and an additional \$649,185 to the state. "It's what most everyone has known for some time now. Full-card simulcasting is a big winner for horsemen, the state, the tracks and, most importantly, the fans who appreciate the variety and guality. It is now time for the Division of Pari-Mutuel Wagering to act decisively and make full-card simulcasting a permanent fixture in Florida," said Calder President Ken Dunn. Last week, the Florida Division of Pari-Mutuel Wagering denied Gulfstream's request to offer full-card simulcasting. The issue will be discussed by the Division during a fact-finding hearing set for January 17.
