EXERCISE RIDER DIES AT HIALEAH Exercise rider Fanny Plummer died Saturday morning after being thrown from the unraced three-year-old colt, Lord Westie, at Hialeah Race Course. Plummer, 37, was galloping the horse for trainer Mike Trivigno. According to an eye witness, Plummer was in an extended gallop, in the middle of the track. After passing the finish line the colt appeared to bolt and missed the club house turn, running into another horse near the outside rail just past the mile pole. Plummer was thrown over Lord Westie's head and into a horse near the rail. She was unconscious for the five minutes it took to get her into the ambulance. Revived in the ambulance, she later succumbed at Jackson Memorial Hospital in Miami. No one else was injured in the accident.

FASIG-TIPTON WINTER MIXED SALE TODAY

The Fasig-Tipton Kentucky Winter Mixed Sale will be held today beginning at 11:00 a.m. at Newton Paddocks in Lexington. A total of 215 horses have been catalogued for the sale, including 129 broodmares, 69 yearlings, 15 horses of racing age and two stallions. Covering stallions include Affirmed, Chief Honcho, Gilded Time, Salt Lake, West by West and Wild Again. Yearlings by such stallions as Known Fact, Mining, Sea Hero, Strolling Along, Strike the Gold, Salt Lake and West By West will also be offered. Last year, 178 horses sold for a total of \$1,756,100 for an average of \$9,866 during the Winter Mixed Sale.

LONDON NEWS STORMS HOME South Africa's Dubai World Cup hope **London News (SAf)** (Bush Telegraph {SAf}) won Saturday's \$64,447 G1 Queen's Plate over a mile at Kenilworth, but Britain's former champion jockey Frankie Dettori had to miss the winning ride after being sidelined with a painful abscess. Ridden instead by Dougie Whyte, London News, the Alec Laird-trained four-year-old, was always handily placed in the race. Once in the straight, the 7-2 second choice soon showed his class and drew away to win by three-and-a-half lengths over 5-2 favorite **Ashtontown (SAf)** (Bush Telegraph {SAf}). This was London News' eighth victory, and owners Laurie and Jean Jaffee still intend to send him to the Gulf for the \$4-million Dubai World Cup in March. "That is still the plan," said Laurie Jaffee, "provided we receive an invitation."

Montjoy, a MGSW in Europe, was off the board in his first two U.S. appearances--a fourth in the GI Man O' War and an eighth in his last start, the GI Turf Classic Invitational October 5. The bay, settled back into 10th in the 12-horse field early, rallied along the rail and just prevailed in stakes-record time. "He's done well since his last race at Belmont," said winning trainer John Kimmel. "He's put on some weight and has done well with our program. We put a tongue tie on him today, and that helped him a lot. They finished up in race horse time today--I'm pleased with him." Kimmel said the Jan. 25 Canadian Turf H. will be next for Montjoy. The 2-1 favorite in the race, **SAME OLD WISH** (Lyphard's Wish {Fr}) was last for a half; he made a late bid on the far turn but could not sustain the rally and finished fourth.

AUSTRALIA HIT BY JOCKEYS STRIKE After weeks of threats, Australia's senior jockeys took strike action Saturday, demanding a 100-percent increase in riding fees. As a result most of the horses racing yesterday in Sydney, Melbourne, Brisbane, Adelaide and Perth were partnered by apprentice jockeys, who are indentured to the racing clubs. Only a handful of senior riders, including Jimmy Cassidy, ignored the Jockeys Association's order not to ride. The jockeys are seeking a riding fee increase from \$51 to \$103, but many owners and trainers are refusing. More lightning strikes are threatened, putting the World Jockeys' Championship, due to start in Australia on January 18, in jeopardy.

I just didn't want to say too much about her before she ran because this is a step up...she also has a lot of steps to take before we can call her great." The filly will take her next step toward greatness in the GII Forward Gal S. at Gulfstream January 22.

WEEKEND PEDIGREE PERSPECTIVES

PEDIGREE SHORTS...

A recent retiree to the stallion ranks who owns a very clever pedigree is **Seacliff (c, 4, Valid Appeal--Eloquack, by Elocutionist)**. Seacliff showed very smart form at two, with victories in all three legs of the Florida Stallion Series. He kicked off 1996 with a win in the GIII Spectacular Bid S., but was injured in that start. Seacliff's sire, Valid Appeal, is out of a mare by Moslem Chief, and Moslem Chief's sister, Believe Me, is the grandam of Seacliff's broodmare sire, Elocutionist, meaning Seacliff has the brother and sister 3x4. Seacliff will begin his stud career at T Square Stud, Fairfield, Florida.

Freshman sire A.P. Indy was represented by a fourth stakes-winner when his daughter, **Hishi Nile (f, 3, A.P. Indy--Katies {Ire}, by Nonocalco)**, captured the G3 Fairy S. at Nakayama Racecourse in Japan. The dam, Katies, heroine of the Irish 1,000 Guineas during her racing career, is racking up an extraordinary international record as a broodmare. Her first foal, a daughter of Kris (GB), named Katies First (what else?), was a stakes-winner in England and France. The second, Jet Route, by Alydar, was multiple stakes-placed in North America. The third, what Katy Did Next, a Nureyev filly, was a stakes-winner in France; and the fifth, Hishi Amazon, by Theatrical (Ire), was a three-time champion in Japan and is the world's all-time leading female money earner. The A.P. Indy--Katies mating is quite an outcross, but it is interesting to note that A.P. Indy is out of a mare inbred to Somethingroyal, a daughter of Princequillo, and Katies has Honeyway, who is out of a three-parts-sister to Princequillo's dam.
