KEENELAND JANUARY OPENS TODAY The fourday Keeneland January Horses of All Ages Sale begins today in Lexington, with 1,329 horses scheduled to go under the hammer. That total is 51 less than the 1,380 catalogued last January; this year's sale consists of 656 broodmares, 422 yearlings, 55 two-year-olds, nine stallions and 187 horses of other ages. The broodmare contingent offers mares in foal to top sires such as Alleged, A.P. Indy, Black Tie Affair (Ire), Caerleon, Carson City, Deputy Minister, Gilded Time, Holy Bull, Salt Lake and Woodman. Sires represented by the yearlings include Alleged, Capote, Carson City, Crafty Prospector, Gilded Time, Storm Bird, Salt Lake and West by West. Sessions begin daily at 10:00 a.m. The 1996 January Sale saw 996 horses and three stallion shares sell for \$30,275,100; two major dispersals, Due Process Stable and Howard B. Keck, accounted for more than \$11 million of that total.

EXTROVALE TOPS FASIG-TIPTON WINTER

SALE Extrovale (Tom Rolfe), a 10-year-old unraced gray mare, topped yesterday's Fasig-Tipton Winter Mixed Sale. The mare, in foal to Gilded Time, is the dam of MSW Royal Vale (Ascot Knight). Consigned by Merefield Farm, agent, Extrovale brought a final bid of \$50,000 from Cypress Farms. In all, 162 horses were sold for a total of \$1,510,100, down 14 percent from last year's total of \$1,757,200 when 180 were sold. The average price was \$9,322, down 4.5 percent from last year's average of \$9,762.

TURFWAY HOLIDAY NUMBERS DOWN Turfway Park's 1996 Holiday Meet, facing stiff competition from two nearby riverboat casinos, ended December 31 with serious declines in on-track business. On-track attendance for the 22-day meet was 40,356, a decrease of 47.4 percent from last year's 26-day meet attendance figure of 76,755. Total on-track handle decreased 44.7 percent, from \$18,170,957 last year to \$10,044,536 this year. Average on-track handle equaled \$456,570, down 37.9 percent from last year's \$698,883 average. The average on-track attendance was 1,834, down 37.9 percent from last year's average of 2,952. Turfway is 45 minutes from a riverboat casino which opened in early October in Rising Sun, Indiana and just 15 minutes from a second boat in Lawrenceburg, Indiana which opened in December.


