### UNBRIDLED'S SONG FACES TWO AT

**GULFSTREAM** Only two challengers could be found to face **Unbridled's Song** (Unbridled) in his four-year-old debut, the \$75,000 Olympic H. at Gulfstream this afternoon. Lining up against the millionaire in the seven-furlong event are two quality sprinters, **Splendid Sprinter** (Valid Appeal), winner of the Kenny Noe Jr. H. at Calder last out, and **Appealing Skier** (Baldski), winner of the GII Hutcheson S. by a half-length over Unbridled's Song last February; the four-year-old was 10th in both the GI Breeders' Cup Sprint and GI NYRA Mile before taking second in the Hallandale H. last out. Winless since his GII Wood Memorial score last April, Unbridled's Song staged his most impressive performance to date over this track, winning last year's GI Florida Derby by 5 3/4 lengths. Second in an Aqueduct allowance to end the campaign November 30, the colt's career is race-to-race, as owner Ernie Paragallo has threatened to send him to the breeding shed if he does not immediately return to the form that made him the 1996 Kentucky Derby favorite.

**COLD KO'S EAST COAST RACING** Freezing temperatures and below-zero wind chill forced the cancellation of racing at Suffolk Downs in East Boston, Massachusetts Saturday afternoon. Qualifying rounds for the track's annual handicapping contest, however, went on as scheduled, using races from Gulfstream and Aqueduct. Additional qualifiers will be held today and next Saturday, January 25. The final round is set for Saturday, February 1. Racing was also canceled at Philadelphia Park Saturday afternoon, and at New Jersey's Garden State Park both Friday and Saturday evenings. The program at Laurel Park in Maryland was called off after Saturday's sixth race. "The jockeys voted as to the cancellation," explained John Mooney, chief operations officer at Laurel. "It was just too cold...their hands were numb." The last four races on the card were abandoned; the featured \$75,000-added Native Diver S. will be rescheduled for Saturday, January 25. With temperatures predicted to moderate, all tracks are expecting to be back in action this afternoon.

Fourth in this event last year, **Alpride (Ire)** (Alzao) was winless in 1996 but hit the board in four of her seven outings, including a second in the GI Ramona H. and a third in the GI Beverly D. The six-year-old backs up to nine furlongs after setting the pace before a fifth-place finish in the 10-furlong GI Matriarch December 1. **Radu Cool** (Carnivalay), first or second in eight of 11 starts, was second in the Flawlessly H. November 16 last out; the lightly raced five-year-old runs well off the layoff.

**FAIR GROUNDS SETS HANDLE RECORD** Total handle on Saturday's card at the Fair Grounds, including on-track, in-state and out-of-state wagering, was \$4,702,530, the highest one-day handle in the track's history. The record figure, 22 percent higher than the previous mark of \$3,843,662 set February 3, 1996, was attributed in part to the fact that several northern tracks called off their live cards due to the severe cold weather.

Arthur L. took the GIII What a Pleasure S. by 17 1/4 lengths December 14, then proved he could win the close ones, too, posting a gutsy nose victory in the GIII Tropical Park Derby on the grass January 2. Looking to make it three consecutive Grade III wins, the speedy Florida-bred set the pace on a clear lead through moderate fractions, then was all out in the final yards to take the photo from 8-5 favorite and GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile runner-up Acceptable. "I would have preferred to give him another week before running him," admitted winning trainer Luis Olivares. "He had two tough races at Calder. But, I thought I had to face the big boys sometime, why not now?" The colt will make his next start in the GII Fountain of Youth S. February 22. "He doesn't have to prove anything to me," said Olivares. "Even if this horse never ran again, I would be very proud of him. But I only have one bullet, and it's him." Acceptable, second throughout, was making his first start since the October 26 Breeders' Cup and just missed. THE SILVER MOVE (Silver Buck) was scratched after suffering a bruised right front foot, according to a report in the *Daily Racing Form*.

5th-GPX, \$29,000, Alw, 4yo/up, 1 1/8m, 1:51 3/5, ft. **BROUGHTON** (c, 4, **Nureyev--Scarlet Native**, by **Raise a Native**) broke through with a maiden win in his Gulfstream debut last out January 8 and made it two straight over the track here. In front after a quarter, the chestnut allowed longshot **KTWOSBUCKAROO** (Buckaroo) (4th) to take over to the top of the lane, then regained control and edged away to a 1 1/4-length tally as the 2-1 favorite. Making the jump right into stakes company in his first trip to Northern California, the Cal-bred settled well back early under regular rider Kent Desormeaux, moved up gradually to reach contention in deep stretch and then grabbed the lead late to prevent 155-1 Dancer's Kolo from lighting up the tote board. The runner-up, on the board in eight of his 11 career starts, a winner over the track and three times stakes-placed at Hastings Park, still paid \$90.60 for the place and completed a \$2,270.20 exacta; 22-1 Esteemed Friend brought home a triple worth \$38,689.20. The bettors' 2-1 selection **FREE HOUSE** (Smokester), winner of the GII Norfolk at two and fourth in the GI Hollywood Futurity last out, was with the pace early but drifted out in the stretch while tiring and finished seventh.

A # will distinguish first-time stakes-winners, a @ will indicate first-time graded stakes-winners, a + will denote winners who are first-time starters, an (S) will be used for state-bred races and an (R) will be used for other restricted races.

Three-year-old colt **Alpha Omega** (SAf), a son of the Sharpo (GB) stallion **Pole Position** (GB) and winner of the recent G1 Premier's Challenge Cup over the course and distance, ran out a comfortable winner of the G1 Cape Argus Guineas over a mile at Kenilworth in South Africa Saturday, beating his more fancied stable companion **Great World** (SAf) (I'm Great {SAf}) by a length and a half. Trained by Gordon Stuart and ridden by Andre du Preez, Alpha Omega has now finished first or second in 10 of his 11 lifetime starts. Despite his success in the Premier's Challenge Cup, Alpha Omega was only third in the betting for the Cape Argus Guineas behind the filly **Arabian Lass** (SAf) (Al Mufti), who had previously won the G1 Cape Fillies Guineas, and **Great World**, who had looked the probable winner as the field entered the Kenilworth straight, having gone four lengths clear. But Alpha Omega went after him and cut him down well inside the final furlong. Arabian Lass disappointed in finishing only fifth of the 16 runners.

A winner in every other start since taking the Peony S. at Hoosier Park in October, Graceful Minister was third in a Turfway allowance last out but once again returned to the winner's circle taking on stakes foes.
