**ON TO DONN FOR 'SONG'** Unbridled's Song (Unbridled) came out of his victory in Sunday's seven-furlong Olympic H. at Gulfstream, feeling "proud, happy, and very confident," said trainer Nick Zito yesterday morning. Zito confirmed that the four-year-old colt, winning his first race since last April, would now be pointed to the February 8 Donn H. at Gulfstream to face **Skip Away** (Skip Trial). "It's a good feeling," said Zito. "I have been quoted for the last month saying I was looking for good things to happen. The last couple of weeks I got very confident, but you can't get overconfident in this business."

**THISNEARLYWASMINE UNDERGOES SURGERY** Thisnearlywasmine (Capote) underwent successful surgery Sunday after fracturing both front ankles during his victory in Saturday's six-furlong San Miguel S. at Santa Anita, according to trainer Randy Bradshaw. The three-year-old colt was making his first start of the year in the race after a two-month layoff. The 4-5 choice, Thisnearlywasmine earned his second stakes victory in the San Miguel. Bradshaw did not indicate what future plans for the colt were.

**STAKES PURSES RAISED AT FAIR GROUNDS** Purses for 23 stakes race, including the track's four graded races, will be raised, according to an announcement by President and General Manager Bryan Krantz yesterday. The Gill Louisiana Derby has been raised from \$350,000 guaranteed to \$400,000 guaranteed, making it the richest stakes race in New Orleans history. The 1 1/16th mile race for three-year-olds is scheduled for Sunday, March 16. The March 9 Gill New Orleans H. will be raised from \$250,000 guaranteed to \$300,000 guaranteed; the March 15 Gill Fair Grounds Oaks has been boosted from \$150,000 guaranteed to \$175,000-added. The March 29 Gill Explosive Bid H. has gone from \$150,000-added to \$175,000-added. Purses on 19 other stakes have also been raised. It is the third purse increase of the season; two previous increases of 5% across the board excluded stakes races.

Sandpit was forced wide crossing the main track into the stretch the first time around, went up to force the pace early, dueled with **BEDIVERE** (El Gran Senor) until late in the stretch and inched clear. **MARLIN** (Sword Dance {Ire}) bumped with Bedivere and steadied in tight quarters late when looking for room and finished third. Following a stewards' inquiry, Marlin was disqualified and placed fifth. A claim of foul by Gary Stevens aboard Marlin against Sandpit was not allowed when stewards determined there was never room for Marlin to get through. Sandpit was making his first start since finishing third in the Aug. 25 Arlington Million and his rider was happy to see him return. "I'm just glad he's back," said Corey Nakatani, who swept both graded stakes at Santa Anita yesterday. Said assistant trainer Gary Mandella, subbing for his father who was vacationing in the Bahamas, "I'd say he's back and as good as he ever was." No definite plans have been made for Sandpit's next start. Gary Stevens, aboard Marlin, came away from the race less than pleased. "I got hammered two different times by the winner around the turn," he said. "They took the wrong number down."

Belle's Flag won the first four starts of her career, capping the streak off with a victory in the Cal Cup Matron at Santa Anita last November. Sent out against graded company in her last two, she finished second in the Bayakoa at Hollywood and again last out in the La Brea at Santa Anita. In her third consecutive Grade II attempt, however, she unlocked the key to graded stakes victory. Coming off the rail down the backstretch, she stalked the early lead, took command leaving the turn and ground out the victory. Trainer Darrell Vienna said that he would consider a start in the Feb. 9 GII La Canada S., but that "nothing is absolutely etched in stone."

**STRONG OPENING FOR OBS WINTER MIXED**

**SALE** The opening session of the Ocala Breeders' Sales Company's 1997 Winter Mixed Sale registered gains yesterday in gross and average over last year's session. A total of 188 horses passed through the ring in the consignor preferred session, selling for a gross of \$2,524,400, an increase of almost \$60,000 despite 11 fewer horses being sold. The overall average for the preferred session was \$13,428, up 8.3% from last year's \$12,389. Top price of the day, \$60,000, was paid by Mike Lightner for a yearling colt from the first crop of End Sweep consigned by Mockingbird Farm.

**OTHELLO TO CRESTWOOD** Othello (Summer Squall) will be the first son to represent his sire at stud, entering duties at Crestwood Farm near Lexington for the 1997 breeding season. He fractured a cannon bone in his left hind in a workout after finishing second in the 1995 GI Del Mar Futurity and underwent surgery, but never made it back to the track. He was retired last year after winning one of four starts and earning \$73,975.
