**SKIP AWAY SHARP AT GULFSTREAM** With jockey Rick Wilson subbing for regular rider Shane Sellers, Eclipse winner **Skip Away** (Skip Trial) blazed through five furlongs in :57 1/5 at Gulfstream Park yesterday morning, according to *Daily Racing Form* clockers. The four-year-old colt, who makes his seasonal bow in the GI Donn H. February 8, galloped out six furlongs in 1:11. Explaining the change of riders for the breeze, trainer Sonny Hine told the *Daily Racing Form*, "We had the same boy galloping him every day and the same rider working him and after a while, the routine gets old; you've got to change things around once in a while. The last time he loafed a bit (seven furlongs in 1:27 2/5 January 17), but today he looked like his old self the way he finished." Wilson had ridden the colt before and was aboard for his 12 1/4-length maiden win at Monmouth in August, 1995, but Sellers will be back in the saddle for the Donn.

**MISSIONARY RIDGE TO PAYSON STUD** **Missionary Ridge (GB)** (Caerleon), who stood at Geret Farm in Pine Bush, New York in 1996, will move to Payson Stud in Lexington for the 1997 breeding season, Payson President Dean Grimm announced yesterday. The 10-year-old stallion, whose first foals hit the racetrack this year, is expected to arrive Tuesday, January 28. A winner of \$1,865,215, Missionary Ridge (GB) pocketed Group races in England and Ireland before shipping to the U.S., where he captured the GII Carleton F. Burke on the grass and the Pacific Classic on dirt, as well as back-to-back runnings of the San Jacinto S. "For speed, performance, soundness, a champion's pedigree and utter honesty it would be hard to beat Missionary Ridge, who raced in the highest class until the age of six," said Grimm. "A horse of his nature comes along only once in a while--and he has the looks to go with it." Missionary Ridge (GB) will stand for a 1997 fee of \$5,000, live foal.

**FRED HOOPER RECOVERING** According to a report in the *Daily Racing Form*, 99-year-old Florida owner/breeder Fred Hooper is recovering from a mild heart attack suffered last Sunday and should be home from the Miami Heart Institute this weekend. "He is resting comfortably," Martha Farmer, a spokeswoman for Hooper Farms, told the *Form*, "and he should be released this weekend...it appears that Mr. Hooper will be okay with no major aftermath."

**COMPADRE TO BLUE RIDGE FARM** Dogwood Stable's multiple graded stakes-placed **Compadre** (El Gran Senor) has been retired and will stand the 1997 breeding season at Blue Ridge Farm in Upperville, Virginia. The durable seven-year-old was on the board in 32 of his 50 career starts for earnings of \$384,389; his 10 stakes placings include the GII Bernard Baruch H. (twice), GIII Ben Ali, GIII Colin, GIII Pilgrim and GIII Saranac. "Dogwood has never had a more admirable horse than Compadre," said Dogwood President Cot Campbell. "For five years he campaigned against the best and acquitted himself well, facing the starter 50 times including a Saratoga first-start, two-year-old win. We campaigned his mother before him, and we will buy and campaign his progeny." Compadre's 1997 stud fee will be announced after he has been test-bred.

**HAWKSTER TO STAY IN U.S.** Hawkster (Silver Hawk), who has been sold to Japanese interests and was expected to stand the 1997 breeding season in that country, will instead spend one more year in the U.S. The 11-year-old stallion, a multiple Grade I winner of \$1,409,477, will stand at Elberton Hill Farm in Darlington, Maryland this year for a fee of \$2,000, live foal. His first foals are four-year-olds of 1997.

**OAKLAWN OPENS TODAY** The 1997 Oaklawn Park meet, delayed for a week by frigid winter weather, opens tomorrow for a 60-day season. The Hot Springs, Arkansas track will offer the highest purses in its history, with a stakes schedule highlighted by the GI \$750,000 Oaklawn H. April 5, the GI \$500,000 Apple Blossom H. April 11 and the GI \$500,000 Arkansas Derby April 13. The opening-day card features the \$40,000 Crabapple S. for older horses going a mile, and the \$50,000 Dixieland S. for three-year-olds at five-and-a-half furlongs. The meet runs through April 13.

#### DANEHILL COLTS TOPS NEW ZEALAND SALE

Cambridge Stud's bay colt by Danehill out of the \*Sir Tristram mare Our Tristralight (NZ) topped the National Yearling Sales at Karaka, bringing a bid of \$457,650 from Rob McAnulty on the second day of the auction. Our Tristralight was champion two-year-old filly in 1991/92 and, as a three-year-old, won the G1 SAJC Sizzler Oaks and G1 Schweppes Australasian Oaks. Sold the same day for \$404,844 was a Royal Academy filly out of the \*Sir Tristram mare Nine Carat (NZ), also bought by McAnulty. The filly, whose dam is a full-sister to the G1 winner Kaapstad (NZ), is a half-sister to the 1995/96 Horse Of the Year Octagonal (NZ) (Zabeel {NZ}). Trainer Graeme Rogerson, who bought the sale topper at last week's Gold Coast Yearling Sales in Australia, bought the session topper on the third and final day of the sale, paying \$309,794 for Pencarrow Stud's colt by former champion sire Marscay (Aus). Rogerson reported that he had bought the colt for a six-person syndicate, made up of three members from New Zealand, two from Australia and one from Hong Kong. Rogerson's purchase is the first foal out of the \*Sir Tristram mare Romanee Conti (NZ), whose seven wins included the Hong Kong International Cup. Overall, the three-day sale produced a gross of \$15,208,054, for an average of \$42,426, up 2 percent from last year. There was a clearance rate of 85.7 percent, the highest since 1987.

**JRA AWARDS ANNOUNCED** Sakura Laurel (Jpn) (Rainbow Quest), a four-time stakes winner last year, has been named the champion Older Horse and Horse of the Year for 1996 by the Japan Racing Association, it was announced yesterday. Now seven, the chestnut Japanese-bred captured the Nakayama Kinen, Tenno Sho, Sankei Sho All Comers and Arima Kinen last year; he was also third in the Autumn Tenno Sho. Also receiving year-end honors were **Meiner Max (Jpn)** (Brian's Time), two-year-old colt; **Mejiro Dober (Jpn)** (Mejiro Ryan {Jpn}), two-year-old filly; **Dance In The Dark (Jpn)** (Sunday Silence), three-year-old colt; Japan Cup runner-up **Fabulous La Fouine (Fr)** (Fabulous Dancer), the only JRA champion not bred in Japan, three-year-old filly; last year's champion three-year-old filly **Dance Partner (Jpn)** (Sunday Silence), older mare; **Flower Park (Jpn)** (Nihon Pillow Winner), sprinter and Japanese-bred; **Hokuto Vega (Jpn)** (Nagurski), dirt horse; and **Polaire (Jpn)** (Ebros), steeplechaser.

**Local News: England**

**Revoque (Ire)** (Fairy King), officially rated the top European two-year-old of 1996, has begun his build-up towards the 2000 Guineas at Newmarket May 3. The unbeaten colt, allotted a mark of 123 when the International Classifications were published last week, resumed preparatory cantering under the watchful eye of trainer Peter Chapple-Hyam Wednesday. "We have just started to do a little bit with him and he looks very well. He hasn't grown a lot during the winter. But, as he was 540 kilos last year, he didn't need to. He is already a good, big horse," said the trainer. No definite target has yet been decided for Revoque's reappearance, although Newmarket's G3 Craven S., in which he would meet Guineas favourite **Bahhare** (Woodman), is being considered. "I will discuss it with the colt's owner Robert Sangster when he comes back from holiday. It is hard to say exactly how far Revoque will stay. His pedigree suggests that a mile or a mile and a quarter will suit him best, so the Guineas is the obvious first major target for him," Chapple-Hyam remarked.

**Local News: Churchill Downs**

A suspected bank robber led police on a chase that ended in surrender in the parking lot of the Churchill Downs Sports Spectrum at 2:20 p.m. yesterday afternoon, according to Jefferson County police spokesman Michael Lehman. Simulcasting at the Sports Spectrum continued without interruption during a one-hour stand-off; patrons were asked to enter and exit the building from doors on the opposite side of the building from where the suspect, Michael Carroll, held police at bay as he threatened to stab himself with a knife before finally giving himself up. **Foreign Report cont.****Local News: Australia**

Trainer Bart Cummings has denied rumours that his star **Saintly (Aus)** (Sky Chase {NZ}) has suffered a serious injury which will scupper his chances of capturing back-to-back G1 Australian Cups. The horse was due to work at Randwick Friday, but due to a minor injury to his near forefoot, he will rest for a few days wearing specially made shoes which will cushion his thin soles. Saintly was only the fourth horse in history to capture both the G1 Cox Plate and G1 Fosters Melbourne Cup, the latter win earning his trainer a place in the record books with a 10th victory in the race.

Cummings said from the New Zealand yearling sales at Auckland, "It is nothing serious...he's okay. It won't affect his campaign too much because we have got plenty of time up our sleeve. He has thin soles and the pressure from the shoe caused a problem." Connections are hoping that Saintly will give his trainer his 12th Australian Cup win at Flemington on March 10.

Jockeys in New South Wales have reached a deal with the Australian Jockey Club which will give them a provisional riding fee of \$65 beginning February 1, up from \$50, until the current scale of pay can be reviewed. While horse owners in New South Wales are not convinced they will be able to afford the increase, New South Wales Attorney General Jeff Shaw, who helped negotiate the agreement, told the *Australian Associated Press*, "Everyone agreed there had to be an increase, and although all parties made compromises, this dispute has been settled with the introduction of the work value review."

**Local News: Ireland**

Three-time Epsom Derby winning jockey Walter Swinburn, whose charity walk across Ireland was completed last week, is now confident his efforts will guarantee the target figure of £50,000 (\$84,700). Swinburn's 10-day trek from County Cork to Dublin was made to raise money for three charities and he has been "absolutely thrilled" by contributors' responses. "I felt right from the start that £50,000 was a realistic figure to aim for, and I think we will make it all right now. There is already around £40,000 in the fund and we are hoping that more will arrive over the next few weeks." He added: "There has been a fantastic response and I am truly delighted by everyone's generosity. Some days I had as many as a dozen people walking with me, so there must have been around 100 of us collecting all told. I would like to thank them too."
