**HOOPER HOME FROM THE HOSPITAL** Fred Hooper Jr., the 99-year-old owner/breeder of top turf horse **Diplomatic Jet** (Roman Diplomat) who suffered a mild heart attack Sunday, January 19, is home in Bal Harbour, Florida and resting comfortably. Hooper was treated at the Miami Heart Institute before being released on Thursday. Jim Picou, who has trained for Hooper for nearly 30 years, said from his barn on the Gulfstream backstretch yesterday, "He's doing fine. I expect to see him drive up here any minute; he just loves coming to see his horses." Picou said Hooper should be well enough to be sitting in his box when Diplomatic Jet makes his 1997 debut in the GII Gulfstream Park Breeders' Cup H. February 15.

### STRUB RUNNERS TOP SANTA ANITA WORK

**TAB** Five candidates for the GI \$500,000 Strub S. February 2 worked at Santa Anita Saturday morning. GII San Fernando Breeders' Cup S. winner **Northern Afleet** (Afleet) went six furlongs over a muddy training track in 1:15 2/5, while **The Barking Shark** (Naevus) went a mile in the mud on the main track in 1:44 3/5. Opting to stretch their legs on the Santa Anita turf, which was labeled "good," GSW **Ambivalent** (Rhodes), runner-up in the San Fernando, went five furlongs in 1:01 4/5; **Mateo** (Lil Tyler) breezed seven furlongs in 1:31 2/5; and **Phantom Quest (GB)** (Rainbow Quest), who will make his U.S. debut for trainer Bobby Frankel in the Strub, worked the same distance in 1:28. Three pointing for the GII San Antonio H. on the same card also appeared on tab yesterday, with **Gentlemen (Arg)** (Robin des Bois), who took the GIII Native Diver H. by nine lengths in track-record time of 1:45 1/5 for the nine furlongs December 22, going seven furlongs in the 1:27 2/5 in the slop at Hollywood Park; GII San Pasqual H. runner-up **Eltish** (Cox's Ridge) getting seven furlongs in 1:28 over the Santa Anita turf; and San Pasqual winner **Kingdom Found** (The Bart) going six furlongs in 1:15 in the mud at Santa Anita. The trio will face GI Breeders' Cup Classic hero **Alphabet Soup** (Cozzene) in the race.

Toga Toga Toga reeled off three straight victories to end her 1996 campaign, culminating in the Pine Tree Lane S. December 1. Back in the gate on New Year's Day, the late-blooming mare was third in the one-mile Run for the Roses H. Getting tested on a wet track for the first time, the five-year-old handled the going with wide late rally that carried her past Ski Dancer in the final yards for her first graded stakes score. "She worked good over a 'good' track, but I wasn't sure if she was going to like the slop or a sealed racetrack," said winning trainer Eduardo Inda, who picked up his first Grade I in the race. "But she was training really good for this race. This is super." Bet down to 2-1 favorite despite running fifth over a track labeled "good" in the GII La Brea S. last out, **ADVANCING STAR** (Soviet Star) pressed the pace through a half in :44 3/5 but had nothing left for the drive and finished last in the six-horse field. "I'll just say the same thing I said after the last time I rode her," said jockey Gary Stevens, who was also aboard for the La Brea. "She did not like the mud, and she never will like the mud."

Sent off as part of the field at 21-1 in the GIII Knickerbocker H. at Aqueduct November 5, Devil's Cup outran his odds and came up just a neck short, finishing second. Encouraged by the performance, trainer John Kimmel sent the colt cross-country to try his luck in the GI Hollywood Derby December 1 and the dark bay acquitted himself admirably once again, finishing third, just a length and a half behind top grass horse Marlin at 12-1. Sixth after pressing a quick pace in the GIII Appleton H. in his seasonal bow, the four-year-old bounced back in his second start of the year, this time stalking more moderate fractions before putting a head in front as they straightened for home and edging clear late to earn his first stakes win in a time that tied the stakes record. "My hat goes off to Devil's Cup, who has been the bridesmaid many times," said winning trainer John Kimmel. "We were actually still on the fence about running him in here until (Friday). I took a look at the *Form* and it looked like he belonged in here. This horse has a lot of class and gets better with age." The colt will make his next start in the GII Gulfstream Park Breeders' Cup February 15. The 2-1 favorite SAME OLD WISH (Lyphard's Wish {Fr}), fourth in the Appleton, showed little and finished ninth.
