NO REFRAIN: CAREER OVER FOR UNBRIDLED'S SONG

The roller coaster racing career of **Unbridled's Song** (Unbridled) has come to an end. The grey who first raised eyebrows when he brought a record bid of \$1.4 million at the 1995 Barretts March two-year-old sale only to be turned back with a chip in his left front ankle, came back lame from a routine gallop yesterday morning at Gulfstream; diagnosed with a fractured right front cannon bone, he has been retired. Now four, Unbridled's Song made headlines at two with his victory in the 1995 GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile, then earned the role of Kentucky Derby favorite after taking the GI Florida Derby and GI Wood Memorial last year. Sent off as the 7-2 choice in the 1996 "Run for the Roses" despite running with two bar shoes in front, the colt swept to the lead at the top of the Churchill stretch after pressing a fast pace, but faded as the field drove to the wire and finished fifth. After much debate, his connections skipped the Preakness and Unbridled's Song instead went off at 1-5 in the GI Peter Pan, only to finish second. His next start saw him face superstar Cigar in the Arlington Citation Challenge in July; not up to the challenge, he crossed the line ninth, some 20 lengths behind the two-time Horse of the Year, and soon after was transferred from trainer Jim Ryerson to Nick Zito. Second in an Aqueduct allowance in his first start for Zito November 30, the millionaire looked to be headed for the breeding shed, but Zito convinced owner Ernie Paragallo to give him one more chance. Unbridled's Song made his last start in the seven-furlong Olympic H. at Gulfstream January 19 and beat two rivals by 3 1/4 lengths. He was getting ready for the GI Donn H. when he was injured. "Mike (Smith) worked him a few days ago and he couldn't pull him up," said Zito yesterday, but added, "He seemed slightly off this week, but X-rays at first did not disclose anything. Today, though, Mike brought him back after a gallop and he seemed off in his right fore. I called Dr. Mark Cheney and the X-rays disclosed the flaking in the cannon bone. After talking with Ernie Paragallo and Doc Cheney, we decided it was in the best interest to retire the horse." Unbridled's Song retires with a record of five wins and four seconds from 12 starts and earnings of \$1,311,800; he will stand the 1997 breeding season at Taylor Made Farm in Nicholasville, Kentucky. "Owning him was the greatest experience," said Paragallo. "From day one we knew he had unlimited potential, but it was unlucky that he couldn't show it all the time."
