**SINGING THE PRAISES OF PULPIT** Making the second start of his career as the 1-5 favorite, the much heralded **Pulpit** (A.P. Indy) stretched out to a mile-and-a-sixteenth in yesterday's sixth race at Gulfstream Park ran back to his dazzling maiden win January 11. On the lead from the start, the bay three-year-old was never really challenged and won handily under jockey Shane Sellers. "I had to let him come home a bit," said Sellers. "I wanted him to get something out of the race. I didn't really let him run last time. It was just a good race for a horse in his second start. He had something left--oh, yea!" Added trainer Frank Brothers, "Not a lot of horses have won their first two races. This is a talented horse. Hopefully he will be a star." Brothers would not commit to a next race for Pulpit. When asked about possibly running the colt in the February 22 GII Fountain of Youth, he said, "It's a huge step, but we will leave our options open." (See chart, p2)

**WINTER WEATHER CANCELS LAUREL AND TURFWAY** Saturday's card at Laurel Park in Maryland was called off due to the snowstorm which dropped six inches on the area. While racing is expected to resume at Laurel this afternoon, Turfway Park officials were forced to cancel the program after the second race Saturday, and Sunday's races have also been abandoned. A week of rain and three inches of snow Friday night left the Florence, Kentucky track unsafe. The Race Book remains open for wagering on full-card simulcasting from tracks across the country, but Turfway has now lost eight days of live racing to inclement weather or unsafe track conditions this year.

**SAINTLY BACK IN STYLE** Australia's equine superstar **Saintly (Aus)** (Sky Chase {NZ}, by Star Way {GB}) confirmed that he has overcome the illness which struck him down on his abortive trip to Tokyo last November when he captured Saturday's G1 \$157,704 C F Orr S. over seven furlongs in Melbourne. Bart Cummings' four-year-old gelding, who had not run since capturing the Melbourne Cup in early November, was winning for the 10th time from 23 lifetime starts while earning over \$3 million. "I thought he was in need of some galloping room, but once he got clear I thought he'd win," said Cummings. "He knows where the winning post is. I've had some good ones and he's right up there with the best of them. He can sprint and stay well and he looks a good chance in the Australian Cup (March 10)."

The script called for last year's champion three-year-old Skip Away to begin his march to Horse of the Year honors here, but Formal Gold rewrote the ending of the first scene while earning his first graded stakes win and giving jockey Joe Bravo his first Grade I victory. The Canadian-bred colt opened his career with an 18 3/4-length win at Monmouth last summer, followed by three wins by a total of 17 1/2 lengths. He stumbled slightly in his jump to graded stakes company, finishing second in the GIII Pennsylvania Derby and the GI Meadowlands Cup H. before running fifth in the GI Breeders' Cup Classic in his last start. Making his four-year-old debut, he took the lead at the break here, setting fractions of :23.66, :47.17, 1:10.85 and 1:35.08. Skip Away stalked the leader throughout, but could not close the gap down the stretch. "I really wouldn't say he's a speed horse," Bravo said of Formal Gold. "He breaks relaxed and he'll rate all day long. We just tried to ride him the way the race was. The race track was covering speed all day, so I just tried to go along with it. My horse did break a tad slow, but after that he knew he was back in the ballgame and took over from there. I was really shocked that they gave me such an easy first half." Jockey Shane Sellers, riding Skip Away, said, "My horse was in perfect position. The only thing I could have done was gun my horse where I could go and soften him (Formal Gold) up, but my horse has been off for too long. I didn't have that kind of horse."
