SKIP AWAY FINE AFTER DONN DEFEAT Trainer Sonny Hine reported yesterday morning that three-year-old champion **Skip Away** (Skip Trial) came out of Saturday's second-place finish in the GI Donn H. in good condition. "He's excellent," Hine said. "He came out of the race bouncing. He ate up everything last night and is feeling good. He walked this morning. We'll jog him a little bit tomorrow." As for the four-year-old's defeat, Hine said, "I think he ran an awful good race. The rail was fast. Formal Gold got the corner on us. The winner ran a powerful race and (Joe) Bravo rode a great race. This will move us forward." Hine indicated that Skip Away will start next in the March 1 GI Gulfstream Park H. "We are eligible for the Santa Anita H. on the second (of March), but we will probably stay here."

FORMAL GOLD HAS BIG 'CAP PLANS GI Donn H. victor **Formal Gold** (Black Tie Affair {Ire}) may make his next start in the \$1 million GI Santa Anita H. March 2. "We're very much thinking about the race," owner John Murphy said Sunday morning. "We haven't made a firm decision as of yet, but it's at the top of our list." The William Perry-trained colt is five for eight and has now earned \$515,100. "We knew he was going to win yesterday," Murphy added. "It was a little surprising that he made the lead so easily. There was so much speed in the race. He proved he's one of the top horses in the country."

OBS-CALDER SELECT TWO-YEAR-OLDS WORK After OBS-Calder Sale honor graduate **Chaposa Springs** (Baldski) made her farewell appearance under tack, the juveniles entered in Tuesday's OBS-Calder Sale of Selected Two-Year-Olds in Training took center stage in their Under Tack Show on the main track. The fastest quarter-mile work of the session was recorded by Hip No. 188, **Decoratedwithroses** (Well Decorated--Tea and Roses), who zipped the distance in :21 4/5. The colt, consigned by Donna W. Wormser, agent, is a half brother to MSW **Reign Dance** (Sovereign Dancer). Three of the youngsters worked quarters in :22 flat: Hip No. 104, a Jebbar colt out of Ladyshill, consigned by Farnsworth Farms; Hip No. 177, **Copelan's Skater** (Copelan--Stolen Skates, by Overskate) consigned by Mark Casse, agent and Hip No. 183, a colt by Fortunate Prospect out of the Super Concorde mare Super Fantastic, also from the Farnsworth consignment. The sale is scheduled for Tuesday, February 11, with one continuous session scheduled to get underway at 11 am.

Belle's Flag won the first four races of her career last year, culminating with a victory in the California Cup Matron H. in November. The filly faltered slightly in making the jump to graded stakes company, finishing third in the GII Bayakoa and second in the GII La Brea, but rebounded in her debut this year with a win in the GII El Encino. Belle's Flag jumped out to the lead here and held a slight advantage while running easily in the early stages. She sprinted clear through the stretch for a confident win. "I had no idea I would be on the lead," said winning rider Corey Nakatani. "The middle of the turn nobody was going, so I let my filly move on a little bit so she wouldn't be pressured the whole way down on the inside. She handled it very well, and sure ran a good race." Second choice **Listening** (Night Shift) appeared ready to rally, but came up empty, finishing sixth. "She's never thrown in the towel in her life before, but she did today," said her rider Chris McCarron. "I thought what a dream trip I was getting the first three-quarters of a mile. When Chile Chatte showed speed going into the first turn, I thought I was in a great spot. But she stopped at the three-eighths pole."

"I liked the way she kicked in, but she came up short," said Storm Song's trainer Nick Zito. "Trust me, things will be completely different next time."
