STORM SONG SET FOR BONNIE MISS Eclipse Award winner **Storm Song** (Summer Squall), fifth in Sunday's GIII Davona Dale S. at Gulfstream to start her three-year-old season, came out of the effort in good order and will make her next start in the GII Bonnie Miss S. March 9. "She's alright this morning," said trainer Nick Zito yesterday. "She was a little disappointed herself. There were a lot of factors involved--it was a tough race. It will be different in the Bonnie Miss. She'll be closer next time, much closer." Also pointing for the Bonnie Miss is nine-length Davona Dale winner **Glitter Woman** (Glitterman). "She's doing fine. I'll probably work her again in about 10 or 12 days," said trainer Shug McGaughey.

OBS-CALDER SALE SET FOR TODAY The OBS-Calder Sale of Selected Two-Year-Olds in Training, which graduated 1996 Eclipse winners Skip Away ('95) and Jewel Princess ('94), will be held today at Calder Race Course. A total of 212 juveniles were catalogued for the auction, including five from the first crop of Gilded Time; two by Glitterman, sire of top three-year-old filly Glitter Woman; and four from last year's top freshman sire Salt Lake. Hip #41, a colt by A.P. Indy--Dance Troupe (Native Charger) consigned by Straightaway Farm, agent, should attract attention as well. The dark bay is a half-brother to MGSW Dance Floor (Star de Naskra). The 1996 Eclipse Award-winning breeder Farnsworth Farm will offer a 32-horse consignment with two-year-olds by Diablo, Fortunate Prospect, Jeblar, Line In The Sand and Robyn Dancer. Videotapes of Sunday's under tack show will be available for viewing on the sales grounds. Bidding begins at 11:00 a.m.

SHOEMAKER CASE IN COURT Hall of Famer Bill Shoemaker's lawsuit against Glendora Community Hospital and the doctors who treated him after the car accident in April, 1991 that left him a quadriplegic is now before a judge in Los Angeles County Superior Court. But, according to yesterday's *Blood-Horse On-Line*, the case against the state of California, which had been sued for failing to erect a guardrail on the stretch of road where the accident occurred, has been dismissed. "Now we can try the case against the doctors without any side issues," Neil Papiano, Shoemaker's attorney, told the *Blood-Horse*. The suit alleges that the medical treatment Shoemaker received immediately after the accident greatly contributed to his paralysis.
