STRICTER SCRUTINY FOR HONG KONG INTERNATIONAL RUNNERS

The Hong Kong Jockey Club will enforce more stringent guidelines and require veterinary checks before runners make the trip to the Far East for this year's International races after pre-race positives forced the scratches of American entrants **Da Hoss** (Gone West) and **Mateo** (Lil Tyler) last December, the *Racing Post* reported yesterday. The two runners tested positive for anabolic steroids, a scenario the HKJC hopes to avoid in the future with the new regulations. "It now becomes mandatory that a horse cannot undergo a course of anabolic steroids if he wants to race here," the HKJC's Director of Racing Philip Johnson told the *Racing Post*. "We are making a point that international racing should be drug free." Purses for the three events, the International Bowl, Cup and Vase, will also be raised this year, with the Cup now worth approximately \$900,000, and the Vase and Bowl worth approximately \$850,000 each.

ARLINGTON TO REPRESENT DUBAI WORLD CUP

Arlington International Racecourse Chairman Dick Duchossois has announced that his track has once again been selected as the American representative for the \$4 million Dubai World Cup, set for March 29. As American rep, Arlington will coordinate all marketing and simulcasting activities for the event in North, South and Central America. Last year, more than \$1.6 million was wagered on the Dubai World Cup in the United States alone. "The Dubai World Cup was extremely well received last year," said Duchossois. "Simulcast locations throughout the country had terrific crowds and the amount of money wagered exceeded everyone's expectations, particularly when you consider the fact that the race was held on Wednesday morning." This year's World Cup will be run on a Saturday, with post time scheduled for 11:15 a.m. EST. Wagering will also be offered on the Dubai Duty Free race this year, with post time at 10:30 a.m. EST. Win, place, show, exacta and triecta wagering will be available on both races; there will also be a daily double on the Dubai duo, and superfecta wagering on the World Cup.

AGENCE FRANCAISE SALE SHOWS GAINS

Agence Francaise held its first sale of the year at Deauville February 13, bringing together both local and foreign trainers, owners and breeders in the Elie de Brignac sales pavilion. The mixed sale had a wide appeal, drawing horsemen from Germany, Switzerland and Italy, and results showed a gross of \$338,097, up 15% from last year, and an average of \$10,245, up over 50%. The top price of \$85,566 was paid for hip number 39, the five-year-old mare **Linoise (Fr)** (Caerwent {Ire}), who is a listed winner and Group-stakes placed; she was purchased by bloodstock agent Eric Puerari. Hip number 15, Group winner **Guest Performer (Ire)** (Be My Guest), a 13-year-old mare in foal to Hernando, sold for \$47,326 to agent Andy Smith for Gary Tanaka; and hip number 33, **Princesa Elena (Fr)** (Esprit du Nord), a four-year-old filly leaving training, was purchased for \$35,021 by Agence Horse France.

A report in yesterday's *Racing Post* revealed that purse money in Britain dropped 2.2 percent last year compared with the record of \$65.856 million in prize money in 1995. The decrease was attributed to the drop in contributions by the Levy Board, a deficit which was reduced by some 40 percent by contributions made by owners, sponsors and racecourse executives.

Local News: New Zealand

One of the most famous bloodstock sales companies in the world, the New Zealand-based Wrightsons Bloodstock, will have its name changed on June 1 following a decision made by the new Board Of Directors this week. Its new name will be New Zealand Bloodstock Company and Board Chairman Peter Vela, who owns the company with his brother Philip, explained the name change: "This company is interested in the views of all 3,000 members of the New Zealand Thoroughbred Breeders Association and not just a select few. There is an open invitation for every breeder to express their views to any member of the Board." Vela also unveiled the dates for the 1998 National Yearling sales. The three-day Premier Sale will take place on January 20-22 and the Select Sale on January 26-28. Vela also reported that a group of New Zealand breeders will be visiting two major Northern Hemisphere breeding stock sales later this year. "There is no doubt that we need to continue to improve the quality of our broodmare band," he said. "This group will be buying at the Keeneland Breeding Stock Sale in Kentucky and at Tattersalls in England. We also plan to buy a number of well-bred fillies in the U.S.A. and Europe, which will be brought to New Zealand and offered at public auction at Karaka in August."
