### PULPIT CONVERTS DOUBTERS WITH FOUNTAIN SCORE

The lightly-raced **Pulpit** (A.P. Indy) took another step towards confirming his superstar status while winning yesterday's GII Fountain of Youth S. at Gulfstream Park. Less than a month removed from a career debut that made him racing's newest sensation and just two weeks after an allowance win that only added to the hype, Pulpit made a smashing first foray into stakes company. The regally-bred colt had led at every point in his previous two starts, but jockey Shane Sellers rated Pulpit behind the speed duel of **Arthur L.** (Ocala Slew) and **Confide** (Phone Trick) here, before turning the bay loose to take charge at midstretch. He then held off the late-closing longshot **Blazing Sword** (Sword Dance {Ire}) by 1 1/2 lengths. Team Valor's **Captain Bodgit** (Saint Ballado), out of the picture in the early going, closed with a rush to finish just a half-length behind Blazing Sword for the show spot. After the fast early fractions, Arthur L. finished fourth and Confide faded to ninth and last. Pulpit, the even-money choice of the Gulfstream crowd, could start next in the March 15 GI Florida Derby, but trainer Frank Brothers will take his time before making any firm decisions. "We're going to enjoy this race," Brothers said. "We'll see how he comes out of this race, we hope fine. We'll leave our options open." A relieved jockey Shane Sellers said, "I was hoping that he had a fair shake. There were two speed horses and I was hoping that I could take him back and I was hoping that I wasn't making the wrong move. I didn't want to get criticized and get beat that way. I went with my instincts and he came through for me." Pulpit's win left Sellers a little awe-inspired. "You know, second, or third, or fourth, I'd have been happy with. Believe me. For him to do it like he did..." he added...eliciting a chorus of amens from the burgeoning Pulpit watchers.

Pulpit defied the disbelievers with a sparkling stakes debut. The colt, a winner of his previous two starts, was made the heavy favorite despite his lack of experience. He settled behind ARTHUR L. (Ocala Slew) and CONFIDE (Phone Trick) as they duelled through torrid fractions of :23.26, 45.67, 1:09.72 and 1:35.61. Pulpit took command at midstretch and drew off to the wire, instantly enhancing his status as the early favorite for the Kentucky Derby. "I've never trained a colt like him before," winning trainer Frank Brothers said after the race. "He has a lot of brilliance to him. He's a runner, a talented colt." Brothers would not commit to a next start for Pulpit, but said, "The Florida Derby (GI March 15) would be a next logical step, but we'll take it one at a time." Jockey Shane Sellers, scoring his first stakes win of the Gulfstream meet, said, "He never had any horses in front of him before. He was fine with it around the first turn and in the backside. Around the last turn, he was kind of looking at those two in front of him and he was kind of shying away from them. I hit him left handed down around the eighth pole...I mean, he just hit another gear. He got a tad tired, but he's a fighter."

**DUBAI HOPEFUL JUGGLER IN SETBACK** Australia's great hope for next month's \$4 million Dubai World Cup, the Gai Waterhouse-trained gelding **Juggler (Aust)** (Jugah), suffered a setback in his preparation when beaten a length and a quarter by the John Hawkes-trained 1995/96 Horse Of The Year **Octagonal (NZ)** (Zabeel {NZ}) in yesterday's \$158,730 G1 Chipping Norton S. over a mile at Warwick Farm in Sydney. The win was Octagonal's eighth G1 victory and he is now set to take on the Bart Cummings-trained Cox Plate-Melbourne Cup hero **Saintly (Aust)** (Sky Chase {NZ}) in the G1 \$992,063 Australian Cup over a mile and a quarter at Flemington March 10, which is also a target for the beaten Juggler. Juggler's trainer Gai Waterhouse was not too disheartened. "Juggler was gallant in defeat," she said, while jockey Glen Boss added, "more than ever Juggler is looking for a longer trip. He didn't quite have that same zip as when he won the Apollo S. last week. He is looking to relax." Juggler's part-owner Peter Horwitz, who is still keen to send the horse to Dubai, said, "Shane Dye just outrode them all."
