**PULPIT FINE AFTER FOUNTAIN WIN** Trainer Frank Brothers reported Saturday's GII Fountain of Youth winner **Pulpit** (A.P. Indy) came out of the race in good order. "He seems fine this morning," Brothers said. "He cooled out fine, ate up last night and his legs are fine. Yesterday's race was a big jump for him and he passed with flying colors. In that sense, I'm relieved. I'm also excited because it looks like he's a nice horse. This was the first big dance for my horse and there will be plenty of them coming up." Brothers added that the March 15 GI Florida Derby still looms as a next step for his three-year-old. "I talked to Seth (Hancock) this morning" Brothers said. "The Florida Derby is the next logical step. If Seth feels comfortable running him back in three weeks, if he's doing good and we're happy with him, then we'll run in there. There are so many three-year-old options, that if we wanted another week or two with him, we'd find a spot." Trainer Nick Zito reported that **Acceptable** (Capote), sixth in the Fountain of Youth bled during the race. "We scoped him after we got him back to the barn," Zito said. "The results showed that he had bled. I think it may have been when he took that misstep near the 3/8 pole. Sometimes the stress of something like that is enough to cause a horse to bleed." Zito is still planning on starting **Acceptable** in the Florida Derby, "assuming everything continues OK."

**WORK** The juveniles entered in Fasig-Tipton's Selected Two-Year-Olds in Training Sale took to the Calder track yesterday morning. The top time for a quarter mile was equaled by two horses. Hip number 15, a grey filly by Horse of the Year **Black Tie Affair** (Ire) out of the Graustark mare **A Stark is Born**, covered the distance in :21.4. That time was also recorded by the chestnut colt **Deputy Ice** (Silver Deputy), hip number 139, out of the unraced **Bold Ruckus** mare **Icelette**. **Deputy Ice** is a full brother to MSW **Sermon Time**. The Selected Two-Year-Olds in Training sale starts today at 7:30 p.m. and continues Tuesday at noon.

"She was ready to go long. She spurted away from them and finished strong." Hine said **Chip** will be given a rest before her next start.

**KNOWLEDGE TAKES BLUE DIAMOND** Australian trainer **Lee Freedman** has saddled the winners of the last four \$1,577,038 **Golden Slipper** and he looks to have a strong hand again this year. At **Caulfield** Saturday, his colt **Knowledge (Aus)** (Last Tycoon {Ire}) gave **Freedman** his first victory in the six-furlong \$788,519 **Blue Diamond S.** The trainer also saddled the runner-up in the race, the filly **Rose Of Danehill (Aus)** (**Danehill**). Starting at odds of 20-1, **Knowledge** beat the 7-1 **Rose Of Danehill** by a neck with **Sports (Aus)** (**Zeditave {Aus}**) three-quarters of a length away in third. "This colt has just a paralyzing finish," **Freedman** commented on **Knowledge**. "Just what you need for a **Golden Slipper**." This was **Lee Freedman's** 77th Group One victory in his career and his 7th of the current season. It was also **Coolmore Stud** stallion **Last Tycoon's** second Group One winner of the week, having been responsible for last Sunday's G1 **Lightning S.** winner **Mahogany**.

**Local News, England:**

Dual Epsom Derby-winning owner Sheikh Hamdan Al Maktoum has added his voice to the growing unrest about the low level of prize money in British racing. The Sheikh, in an article in the Middle Eastern newspaper *Gulf Today*, said: "Racing is an expensive hobby--no one can rely on the sport to make big profits--but you should be able to cover your expenses." Sheikh Hamdam, whose younger brother Sheikh Mohammed is the largest single owner-breeder of horses in Europe, added: "We were first attracted by the traditions of British racing, but you just can't go on investing all the time."
