RUNNING FLAME TO SAUDI ARABIA Francebased Running Flame (Fr) (Assert {Ire}), winner of the GI Hollywood Turf Cup in his only stateside start Dec. 15, is now being aimed at Saudi Arabia's March 21 King's Cup and is scheduled to prepare for the main event this Friday, Top British jockey John Reid has been booked to partner the five-year-old in both races and flies out to the Middle East Wednesday. Reid said, "Running Flame has some very good form and, if he stays the two miles of the King's Cup, will have a great chance of winning. His best form is over a mile and a quarter and I don't think he has run over more than a mile and a half." Running Flame had a stellar four-year-old campaign in 1996. In addition to winning the Hollywood Turf Cup, he took the G3 La Coupe de Maisons-Laffitte and was placed in a pair of listed stakes in France.

Saturday, Gulfstream Park

PAN AMERICAN H.-GII, \$300,000, 3vo/up, 12fT Lassiany (Gone West), winner of the GII Gulfstream Park Breeders' Cup H. last out, heads the list of probables for this Saturday's feature race at Gulfstream. The likely favorite equaled the course record for the mile and three-eighths in his latest test; he will try to give trainer Bill Mott his fourth Pan American win. Also pointing for the event is Gulfstream Park Breeders' Cup runner-up Flag Down (Deputy Minister). The seven-year-old was beaten in a photo in that race. Said trainer Christophe Clement, "He got beat a dirty head. When I get beat by a head, it's always a dirty head. When I win by a head, it's a very nice, clean head." MGISW Awad (Caveat), third behind the top two last out, looks to improve off that effort, "He really didn't settle," said trainer Dave Donk of the race. "He was a little bit skittish in the paddock. It was a little bit early in the year for him. As the year goes on, he usually rounds into form." Five-year-old Diplomatic Jet (Roman Diplomat), himself a multiple Grade I winner, and Marcie's Ensign (Blue Ensign) are also expected in the gate Saturday.

Sunday, Santa Anita

SANTA ANITA OAKS-GI, \$200,000a, 3yo, f, 8.5f Sharp Cat (Storm Cat), the top filly in the West, had her final prep for the Oaks at Santa Anita yesterday morning. Daily Racing Form clockers caught the Team Lukas runner going five furlongs in 1:01 3/5. The talented chestnut has reeled off three straight since a disappointing ninth-place finish in the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies last October, taking the GI Hollywood Starlet in December, the Santa Ysabel by 14 lengths in January, and the GI Las Virgenes by a dominant 5 1/2 lengths last out February 15.
