LIFE OF LEISURE FOR CIGAR? With the latest evidence indicating that there is virtually no hope **Cigar** (Palace Music) can fulfill stallion duties, Allen Paulson yesterday outlined a plan to reacquire his seven-year-old champion and bring him home to his Brookside Farms in Versailles, Kentucky. Paulson said that Cigar's sperm shows no motility and that none of the additional mares who had been scanned had proven to be in foal. "There is (no hope) that I can see," said Paulson. "It has been zero," he said. "There are none in foal. The sperm is not active." Paulson sketched out plans for what he hoped would be the two-time Horse of the Year's future. He said that Lloyd's of London, which he named as the firm who insured Cigar's fertility, would first take possession of the champion. "The insurance company ends up with the horse," said Paulson. "I don't know what they would do with him, but I hope to make a deal so that he can lead his life on my farm. I'll do whatever I have to do." Paulson admitted that chances of Cigar returning to the races were slim. "That would be up to (trainer) Bill Mott and the horse's condition," he said. "He's had a long racing career and I know Bill Mott has mixed emotions about it. The main thing is to give Cigar pleasant surroundings the rest of his life. We would like to keep him on our farm."

FIRST FOAL FOR PHONE CHATTER Champion **Phone Chatter** (Phone Trick) gave birth to her first foal on March 5. Herman Sarkowsky's six-year-old mare produced a filly by *Gone West* at Crystal Springs Farm in Lexington, Kentucky. **Phone Chatter** was named the 1993 Eclipse Award winner as top two-year-old filly after winning that year's GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies, GI Oak Leaf S. and GIII Sorrento S. She retired with earnings of \$838,741 from five wins, three seconds, and one third and will be bred back to *Storm Cat*.
