JEWEL PRINCESS WINS AGAIN Last year's champion older mare **Jewel Princess** (Key to the Mint) added another grade one victory to her resume with a half-length score in yesterday's Santa Margarita H. at Santa Anita. The five-year-old mare capped off her championship season with a win in the GI Breeders' Cup Distaff and returned to take her 1997 debut in the GI Santa Maria H. February 16. She was able to garner a third-straight grade one win yesterday with a four-wide rally turning for home and a determined stretch run that got her to the wire 1½ lengths in front of second choice **Top Rung** (Seattle Slew). "Her mind and the way she's been training, she's doing better now than she was last year," said winning trainer Wally Dollase. "She's not worried about a thing. She ran a good one. I'm very excited and obviously pleased she won." Jewel Princess, the 1-2 favorite of the Santa Anita bettors, may start next in the April 11 Apple Blossom H. at Oaklawn Park. With her win yesterday, the bay mare brought her record to 13 wins in 24 starts for earnings of \$1,684,560.

SHARP CAT TAKES SANTA ANITA OAKS **Sharp Cat** (Storm Cat) earned her seventh victory in 10 starts with a wire-to-wire score in yesterday's GI Santa Anita Oaks. Coming off a 5½-length tally in the GI Las Virgenes S. February 15, the filly was made the prohibitive 1-5 favorite of the Santa Anita crowd and gave her backers no anxious moments while drawing off easily through the stretch for another 5½ length win. Trainer D. Wayne Lukas is now considering Sharp Cat's next start which may be against the boys in the April 5 Santa Anita Derby. "I'd have to say, without discussing things over with The Prince (owner Ahmed Salman of The Thoroughbred Corp.), that we're looking at the Ashland (Keeneland, April 5 against fillies) or the (Santa Anita) Derby here," Lukas said after the race. "We might stay within our own sex for a while yet, too. There's something to weigh. Number one, do you go out of your own stall and go on a track that she has an affinity for? Or do you take a chance going to Keeneland and catching a rain-storm. We'll just weigh all the options." To date, Sharp Cat has earned \$797,850.

Champion Jewel Princess, coming off a five-length triumph in the GI Santa Maria H. in her seasonal bow February 16, rated just behind the early leaders before rallying four-wide into the stretch to wear down Top Rung. "I thought the 125 pounds might stop her, but Corey (Nakatani) rode a perfect race," winning trainer Wally Dollase said. "He didn't hurry her the first part of it and he was on the best horse." Nakatani, adding this win to an earlier victory aboard Sharp Cat in the Santa Anita Oaks, swept the two grade one races on yesterday's Santa Anita card. Belle's Flag was scratched from the race due to swelling in her left foreleg.

Sharp Cat may have earned herself a spot in the Kentucky Derby picture with an easy win here. The filly, a winner of the GI Las Virgenes S. in her last outing February 15, led from start to finish for an authoritative score. Asked if the precocious filly might be his best hope for a 1997 Derby win, trainer D. Wayne Lukas said, "If they ran it tomorrow, probably. We'll just have to let that sort itself out. If they entered tomorrow, I guess she would be." Winning jockey Corey Nakatani said, "She's got a mind of her own, but she's getting better and she's going to continue getting better just with racing. I really think she can go a mile-and-a-quarter and I don't think she would be intimidated by colts."

Glitter Woman, a 9 3/4-length winner of the Jan. 22 GIII Forward Gal S. and the nine-length winner of the Feb. 9 GIII Davona Dale S., continued her dominance at Gulfstream with another romp. The favorite chased the pacesetter Dixie Flag in second before taking command around the far turn en route to another impressive victory. "Shug (trainer McGaughey) felt that she would be close to the pace today, if not setting the pace herself," Roger Edwards, assistant trainer for Shug McGaughey, said. "He was right. She got her position early. When they started running, she went on. It was an easy win for her today." Southern Playgirl trailed the field early and came back to grab the place spot. AJINA (Strawberry Road {Aus}), making her 1997 debut, tracked the leaders but weakened in the stretch to finish fourth. Champion STORM SONG (Summer Squall), the 7-2 second choice, disappointed again as she finished last, 22 lengths behind the winner.

"Wild Tempest had been running on the lead, so we thought we'd try something different," Nick Zito, trainer of the winner, said. "We took him off the pace, and it worked."
