**MANDELLA'S DUBAI DUO WORK** Trainer Richard Mandella sent his two Dubai World Cup hopefuls out to work yesterday morning at Santa Anita in preparation for the March 29 race. **Siphon (Brz)** (Itajara {Brz}), winner of the GI Santa Anita H., worked three furlongs in :37 2/5. **Sandpit (Brz)** (Baynoun {Ire}), a MGISW and second to his stablemate in the Big 'Cap also worked three furlongs. The eight-year-old chestnut covered the distance in :36.

**FORMAL GOLD ON TRACK FOR WORLD CUP** Trainer Bill Perry reported that GI Donn H. champion **Formal Gold** (Black Tie Affair {Ire}) breezed at Hialeah yesterday morning in preparation for the March 29 Dubai World Cup. "He went well and (owner) Mr. Murphy was out to see the workout this morning (Wednesday)." Formal Gold was sixth in the March 2 Santa Anita H. in his most recent start. "As of now, the horse will leave on Sunday (from Miami) for Dubai," Perry said. "Joe Bravo is scheduled to ride him." Formal Gold worked three furlongs in :37.3 and went out in :49.

**TWO-YEAR-OLDS RETURN TO SANTA ANITA** **Beat the Devil** (Diablo) won the first 1997 race for two-year-olds at a major American racetrack when the filly captured yesterday's first race at Santa Anita. A daughter of last year's leading freshman sire by winners and a \$50,000 acquisition at last month's OBS Select Sale of Two-Year-Olds in Training at Calder, Beat the Devil was bet down to 3-5 off a pair of bullet workouts over the Santa Anita track. Although off a half-step tardy, she rallied down the center of the track to win going away, running the quarter-mile distance in :21 2/5.

"He worked kind of lazily the other day," trainer Bob Baffert said. "If you watch him work, he'll drive you nuts. Thank God he shows up on race day." Baffert added the plan is to send the gray three-year-old to the Santa Anita Derby April 5. "This time of year, you're just kind of forced into tackle the big guns. But I think he's one of the big guns. I wouldn't change him for anybody, except maybe Pulpit." Silver Charm, a winner of three of four starts, has been off since taking the Feb. 8 San Vicente. The colt was also victorious in last year's GII Del Mar Futurity. **Constant Demand** (Summer Squall), third in the GIII Hollywood Preview S. last year, is still only possible for the race. The colt worked a bullet five furlongs in :59 Wednesday morning.

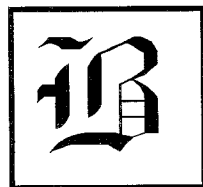
