DAILY RACING FORM FOR SALE According to Wednesday's *New York Daily News*, K-III Communications, owner of the *Daily Racing Form*, is looking to sell the racing publication. The media conglomerate, which publishes *Seventeen* and *New York* magazines, also hopes to dispense of *New Woman* and *Pro Football Weekly* in order to reduce its debt and concentrate on concerns with more potential for growth. The *Daily News* reported that K-III purchased the *Form* from Rupert Murdoch in 1991 for \$650 million, and that the change of ownership will be the newspaper's third in the past 12 years. "The publications up for sale) have served their usefulness," Bishop Cheen, an analyst with First Union Capital Markets, told the *Daily News*. "It's time to take the profits and move on."

KAMMTARRA TAKES MAKTOUM ROUND

THREE Kammtarra (Zilzal) appears likely to gain an invitation to the March 29 Dubai World Cup after his victory in the third and final round of the Sheikh Maktoum bin Rashid Al Maktoum Challenge at Nad Al Sheba Thursday. **Gothenberg (Ire)** (Polish Patriot) set out to make all the running in this mile and a quarter test, but Kammtarra, partnered by Frankie Dettori, swept into the lead inside the final furlong to beat **Tamhid** (Gulch) by a length and a half. **Learmont** (Lear Fan) finished third with Gothenberg fading to fourth in the field of five.

BELLE'S FLAG OUT FOR SEVERAL MONTHS

GII La Canada S. winner **Belle's Flag** (Avenue of Flags) will get an extended vacation from the race-track, according to her trainer Darrell Vienna. The filly was scratched from last Sunday's GI Santa Margarita with swelling in her left foreleg and has now been sent to owner Ernest Auerbach's farm in Ramona to recuperate. "We'll give her four or five months," Vienna said. "She'll be back later in the year and we expect that she'll be 100 percent." Undeclared in two starts this year, the four-year-old's career to date includes six victories in eight efforts for earnings of \$416,909. In addition to the La Canada S., Belle's Flag earned victories in the 1997 GII El Encino, and last year's California Matron H. and Fleet Treat S.

20-1 SHOT WINS CHELTENHAM GOLD CUP The 20-1 outsider **Mr Mulligan (Ire)** (Torus {GB}), trained at Lambourn in England by Irishman Noel Chance and ridden by champion jump jockey Tony McCoy, ran away with Thursday's Cheltenham Gold Cup Steeplechase over three miles and 2½ furlongs, the most prestigious weight-for-age jump event in Europe, beating the 33-1 outsider **Barton Bank (Ire)** (Kambalda {GB}), with Irish-trained 10-1 shot **Dorans Pride** third. The nine-year-old Mr Mulligan led almost the whole way and won by nine lengths on only his third start this season, completing a famous "double" for McCoy, who on Tuesday won the Champion Hurdle on the Martin Pipe-trained **Make A Stand (GB)** (Master Willie {GB}), who also led the entire way in the two-mile event.
