### HOLLYWOOD ANNOUNCES 1997 STAKES

SCHEDULE Hollywood Park, which will host the 1997 Breeders' Cup November 8, will offer 50 graded stakes, 17 of them Grade Is, during this year's spring/summer and autumn meetings. Stakes purses for the two meets, including the \$11 million in Breeders' Cup events, will total more than \$21.7 million. The \$1 million Hollywood Gold Cup, second leg of the MGM Grand Classic Crown, highlights the 59th spring/summer season, which begins April 25. The mile-and-a-guarter test, set for June 29, will be run as a weight-for-age event for the first time this year. "Our philosophy is to let the horses run with equal weight and may the best horse win," said Hollywood Racing Secretary Martin Panza. The 66-day spring stand features an additional four Grade I races, 14 Grade IIs, nine Grade IIIs and \$6.5 million in stakes purses. "Super Sunday," with three graded stakes worth \$900,000 on the final Sunday of the meet, July 20, sees the return of the GII \$400,000 Sunset H. at a mile and a half on the grass; the race will share the card with the GI \$400,000 Vanity H., up from \$300,000 last year, and the GIII \$100,000a Hollywood Juvenile Championship. The GII \$500,000 Swaps S. has been moved up a week and will be run July 13, five weeks after the Belmont S, and three weeks before the GI Haskell Invitational at Monmouth Park. "We felt the move would help us attract more top three-year-olds nationwide," said Panza. The 14th renewal of the autumn meeting, set for November 7 through December 21, showcases the seventh annual Hollywood Turf Festival November 28-30, with six turf stakes offering \$2.15 million in purses. The three-day Festival is highlighted by the GI \$700,000 Matriarch and G! \$500,000 Crown Royal Hollywood Derby, both set for Sunday, November 30. The Breeders' Cup card November 8 will also include the GIII \$100,000 Hollywood Prevue S., \$100,000 Desert Stormer H. and \$150,000 Steinlen H. In all, 22 graded races and stakes purses totaling \$15.2 million will be available for the 1997 fall meet at the "Track of Lakes and Flowers."

The Florida forecast was calling for rain into Friday evening, but even if the track is muddy for the Florida Derby, trainer Frank Brothers will send Pulpit (A.P. Indy) to the gate. "He's doing fine," said the conditioner. "He's never run on an off track, so we'd have to see how he would handle it. But we'll run anyway." The undefeated colt is likely to have things his own way on the front end in his first Grade I attempt, owning the best speed in the race. "I think Pulpit will pretty much dictate the race," said trainer Gary Capuano, who saddles Fountain Of Youth third Captain Bodgit (Saint Ballado), adding, "With the lack of speed in there, I just hope we won't be as far back as we were last time." The colt closed from 21 lengths off the lead to finish two lengths behind Pulpit in that mile-and-a-sixteenth contest.

California Horse Racing Board Commissioner Jack Fenley has proposed a new wager, called the "Pick Six One," which he hopes will stir interest in racing with large carryovers and possible million-dollar jackpots. The latest draft of the "Pick Six One" rules will be discussed during a meeting, open to the public, of the CHRB Parimutuel Operations Committee Thursday at 10:30 a.m. at the Embassy Suites in Arcadia. The new wager is designed to make it more challenging to collect carryover pools, requiring that 15 percent of the daily net handle on the bet be carried over until there is only one handicapper who correctly selects all the winners in the six races of the bet. The remainder of the pool would be distributed daily, whether or not anyone picked all six winners. In current Pick Six pools, 60 percent of the handle is carried over daily until someone selects all six winners, and then the carryover is divided between all of the handicappers who do so. "The pool is designed to return more money to bettors each day in the form of major and minor awards, so they will have the money to reinvest the next day," said Fenley. He added, "Having big carryovers is one thing, but getting people to notice them is another. Each racetrack and simulcast facility should purchase advertising space in their local and regional newspapers on a daily basis, and the ads should be in the same space every day so that fans know where to look for them. People will get into the habit of looking at the ad, and when the carryover gets large enough...that's when they'll pack up the family and head to the races."
