### INJURIES ON GULFSTREAM TURF MAR

**CLOSING WEEKEND** The favorites in two of the three graded turf stakes on closing weekend at Gulfstream Park did not finish their respective races and the last two races of the meet were moved to the main track after jockeys refused to ride over the course, which had been soaked by heavy rains Friday. Saturday, four-year-old **Devil's Cup** (Devil's Bag), the 9-5 favorite in the Gill Ft. Lauderdale H., suffered a fractured right front sesamoid leaving the backstretch of the mile-and-a-sixteenth race; while the injury is not life-threatening, the colt has been retired. Sunday's Gill Orchid H. was marred by a pair of incidents as first **Look Dagers** (Diesis {GB}) broke down going into the grandstand turn the first time, and then the 4-5 favorite **Ampulla** (Chief's Crown) was eased on that same turn the final time around. Ampulla was able to gallop back to be unsaddled and jockey Shane Sellers said, "I was trying to stay off the fence; it was so slick down there. She was getting out...the second turn, I just pulled her up. I couldn't hold her in. (When she came back), she was real bad behind." The Pat Byrne trainee walked off the track, and her conditioner said she appeared to be okay; the multiple graded stakes winner was purchased by Will Farish for a reported high six figures just last week. Look Dagers was not as fortunate; vanned back to trainer Bill Mott's barn, the five-year-old is in critical condition with a fractured pelvis. Dr. Stephen Selway said the mare was hemorrhaging and the next 48 hours would tell if they would be able to save her. In Sunday's 10th race, GISW **Turk Passer** (Turkoman), a seven-year-old gelding making his first start of the season for a \$62,500 tag at a mile and an eighth on the grass, broke his left hind stifle and had to be humanely destroyed. The winner of the 1995 GI Turf Classic and \$735,050 had not started since running ninth in an allowance test at Aqueduct last November 3. Following the race, jockeys informed the stewards they wanted the final two races, originally scheduled for the turf, switched to the dirt. "The jockeys are saying the turns are a little slick, and they would rather ride on the dirt," said steward Walter Blum. A statement by Gulfstream President Douglas Donn read, "The jockeys deemed it unwise to continue racing on the turf, and since there was no time to question their judgement, the management agreed to their request to take the races off the turf."

Winner of the Gill Norfolk S. at Santa Anita last October, Free House was then off the board in three subsequent starts before getting back on track with his second start of the year, running second to favored Silver Charm in the Gill San Vicente S. Unwilling to rely on that form reversal, the bettors let the Cal-bred go off at a generous 10-1 but he proved his last was no fluke, dueling with King Crimson through honest early fractions, taking the lead at the top of the stretch and then turning back the late bid of the crowd's choice for the win. "This horse, when he learns to run and realizes all of his abilities, is going to be a very tough horse to beat," said trainer Paco Gonzalez. "He's still green, and he's already a nice horse." The colt will make his next start in the GI Santa Anita Derby April 5, as will runner-up Silver Charm; third-place King Crimson, who made his stakes debut and his fourth career start here, will also take a look at that race. Second choice HOLZMEISTER (Woodman), making his first start since November, was with the pace from the start and weakened late to be fifth. "It looked like he might have needed the race," said trainer Richard Mandella. "He looked like he got a little tired, but this might help him."

Crypto Star made his debut at the Fair Grounds, finishing third Dec. 30. He then won a Jan. 23 maiden race and a Feb. 10 allowance race by 10. Second, beaten a length in his stakes debut, the Feb. 23 Risen Star S., he returned to the winner's circle as the second choice in his first graded try. The colt raced at the back of the pack early before beginning his late bid around the far turn and making a furious charge down the middle of the track to just get up. "Being back off the pace seems to be the colt's style," winning jockey Pat Day said. "He put in a good run the other day and Wayne (Catalano, winning trainer) said that if he starts running, to get aggressive, and that's what we did." Added Catalano, "The Blue Grass (April 12) is what we're aiming at, but I have to talk to (owners) Mr. & Mrs. Yates to see what's next." Favored Smoke Glacken set a hot pace and hung in gamely through the stretch.

**FLORIDA DERBY WRAP-UP** Captain Bodgit (Saint Ballado), impressive winner of Saturday's Florida Derby, is doing well after his first Grade I success and appears on track for the Blue Grass at Keeneland April 12. "He came out of the race super," said trainer Gary Capuano from his barn at Hialeah Sunday morning. "He's a little tired, but that's to be expected. Right now, (the Blue Grass) looks real good." Capuano added that he will likely wait until the first of April before shipping north to Kentucky. Trainer Frank Brothers said yesterday that **Pulpit** (A.P. Indy), runner-up as the 2-5 favorite in the nine-furlong test, came out of the race in good order, but as for what's next, the horseman said, "We'll leave our options open...(but) the Blue Grass is certainly an option. If we don't go, there are some other things we can do. There is a race every weekend somewhere in America--that would be fine if we want to wait and regroup. It's all speculation right now. It would be foolish to say we're going to do this or that until we know where we stand with the horse." The colt heads to Churchill Downs Tuesday. Trainer Robert Durso said his third-place finisher, **Frisk Me Now** (Mr. Frisky), would be pointed for either the Wood Memorial at Aqueduct April 12 or the Arkansas Derby at Oaklawn the same day. **Acceptable** (Capote), who disappointed once again with his seventh-place finish, may have had an excuse. "He displaced his soft palate," said veterinarian Dr. Mark Cheney. "When that happens, it shuts their air down. I would have to say that it happened in his last race, too. I'm confident this is a legitimate excuse." Trainer Nick Zito will try a change of equipment for his next start, which could be in either the Wood Memorial or the Blue Grass; Zito's **Jack Flash** (Sovereign Dancer), fourth in the Florida Derby, will also head for one of those spots.

**SIMULCASTING BOOSTS GULFSTREAM PARK HANDLE**

With the introduction of full-card simulcasting, total handle during Gulfstream's 1997 meet, which ended Sunday, rose 3.6 percent, from \$574,117,233 in 1996 to \$594,939,751 this year. While on-track handle was also up, showing a 4.6 percent gain, wagering on-track on Gulfstream's live card fell off 10.3 percent as the handle on imported signals rose 318 percent. State-wide, the handle on simulcast races was up an eye-opening 3,385 percent, from \$524,807 before the introduction of full cards, to \$18,289,167 this year. The on-track attendance remained stable, averaging 10,454 this year as compared to 10,374 in 1996.

**HIALEAH OPENS TODAY** Hialeah Park opens this afternoon for a 61-day spring meet. Highlighting the season will be the 66th running of the GIII \$200,000 Flamingo S., to be run April 5. The Triple Crown prep will be broadcast live on ESPN. The Hialeah stakes program also features the GIII \$200,000 Widener H., set for March 22, the GII \$200,000 Black Helen H. April 12 and the GIII \$200,000 Hialeah Turf Cup April 19. In addition to the action on the track, popular weekend family entertainment features will be held in the north paddock area, including live concerts, puppet shows and a special Easter Egg Hunt. The track will race seven days a week for the first 24 days of the meeting, then go to a six-day racing week, with Thursdays dark, starting April 10. First post is set for 1:15 p.m. daily. The meet ends Thursday, May 22.

**TWO-YEAR-OLDS WORK AT OCALA** Hip# 314, a colt by Known Fact, and Hip# 340, a filly by Deposit Ticket, topped the workouts at yesterday's Under Tack Preview for the Ocala Breeders' Sales Company's March Select Sale of Two-Year-Olds in Training, set for March 25 and 26. Consigned by Ricky Leppala, the colt, first foal from stakes-placed Skybox (Spend a Buck), worked an eighth of a mile in :10 1/5. That time was matched by the filly, a daughter of the unraced Stormy Gaylord (Storm Cat) who was consigned by Windfall Farm, agent. Five juveniles stopped the clock at :21 4/5 for a quarter-mile; they were Hip# 218, a colt by Copelan--Minute Into Hours (Dauphin Fabuleux); Hip# 247, a colt by Diablo--Notably (In Reality); Hip# 273, a colt by Diablo--Queen Ginni (Ginistrelli); and Hip# 280, a filly by Copelan--Regal Pennant (Banner Bob), all consigned by Mark Casse, agent; and Hip#320, a colt by Dixie Brass--Solo Haina (Solo Landing), consigned by Melissa Hunt, agent.
