SHARP CAT WORKS MGISW Sharp Cat (Storm Cat) worked Tuesday for the first time since her impressive March 9 Santa Anita Oaks win. The three-year-old bay filly went a half-mile in :47 3/5. "We're just trying to keep her sharp," trainer D. Wayne Lukas said. "We'll pick up the pace a little bit in the next couple of works before we run her. We're leaning very strongly toward going to the Santa Anita Derby (Apr. 5), if everything goes on-target and her works are good." Undefeated in three starts this year, Sharp Cat has seven wins in 10 starts to date for earnings of \$797,850.

DUBAI DOINGS Jerry Bailey, who partnered Cigar to win the inaugural Dubai World Cup last year, will have a prime opportunity to score a second victory in the desert. The Eclipse-award winning jockey will ride last year's champion turf horse Singspiel (Ire) (In the Wings {GB}) in the March 29 race. The Michael Stoute trainee won last year's GI Canadian International and Japan Cup and is owned by Sheikh Mohammed bin Rashid al Maktoum, Bailey replaces Gary Stevens, who has riding commitments that weekend in California. Stevens was on board Singspiel last September when the pair won the Canadian International at Woodbine. Other riding plans for the \$4 million mile-and-a-guarter race: Kammtarra (Zilzal), Frankie Dettori; Luso (GB) (Salse), Michael Kinane and Flemensfirth (Alleged), Gary Hind. Following a break in the rainy weather, Dubai racing authorities are hoping to re-open the main track at Nad Al Sheba for training Thursday. Trainer Richard Mandella's Dubai hopefuls had their final prep for the World Cup Monday at Hollywood Park. Sandpit (Brz) (Baynoun {Ire}) worked a bullet six furlongs in 1:11 3/5. Siphon (Brz) (Itajara {Brz}) worked the same distance in 1:12 1/5. The pair left for Dubai Tuesday.

RUBIANO FILLY SETS RECORD AT TTBA SALE

A two-year-old filly by Rubiano out of Halo Ho (Halo) topped Tuesday's Texas Thoroughbred Association/Lone Star Park at Grand Prairie Two-Year-Old in Training Sale, bringing a final bid of \$105,000. Consigned by Double Diamond Ranch, the gray set a record as the highest-priced two-year-old ever sold at auction in Texas. The half-sister to multiple-stakes winner and graded-stakes placed Tempered Halo (Blade) was purchased by Greg Goodman, son of the late Harold Goodman. A total of 152 horses sold for \$2,347,300 at the auction, an average of \$15,443. The median price was \$10,500. There were 113 two-year-olds listed as not sold.
