MATTY G TO DARBY DAN IN '98 **Matty G** (Capeote), a graded stakes winner at two and three who is currently getting ready for his four-year-old campaign in California, will retire to Darby Dan Farm in Lexington, Kentucky at the end of 1997. The Kentucky-bred colt, a winner of four of his 15 career starts and \$438,125 to date, posted a seven-length victory in the GI Hollywood Futurity at two and captured the Gill Ascot H. at three; he was also third in the GII San Rafael S. and the Santa Catalina S. last year. A half-brother to MGISW Star Of Cozzene, Matty G will be syndicated by Darby Dan; his stud fee will be set at the end of his racing career.

PAWNEESE DEAD AT 24 According to a report in the *Racing Post*, 1976 English Horse of the Year **Pawneese (Ire)** (*Carvin 2nd) collapsed in her paddock at Coolmore Stud in Ireland Tuesday and died. The 24-year-old mare, bred and still owned by Daniel Wildenstein, was in foal to Tirol (Ire) at the time of her collapse; the foal was delivered by Caesarian section, but could not be saved. The champion filly in both England and France at three, Pawneese reeled off six straight victories during the summer of '76, including the Epsom Oaks, Prix de Diane and King George VI & Queen Elizabeth S. The mare's last foal, a 1996 colt by Bigstone (Ire), was never healthy and died in the fall; she has a three-year-old colt by Royal Academy, Pilot In Command (Ire), in training with Andre Fabre.

NTA ADDS FIVE "FOUNDING MEMBERS" The National Thoroughbred Association yesterday announced the names of five new "Founding Members." John T. L. Jones, Niall O'Callaghan, Virginia Payson, Sid Port and Robert Sangster have each pledged to loan the NTA \$50,000 to fund the start-up of the organization. This brings to 66 the number of "Founding Members" who have joined the NTA; the goal is to get 100 and raise \$5 million. John R. Gaines, chairman of the NTA Policy Board, said, "The momentum is really starting to build and leaders in the industry are saying loud and clear the status quo is unacceptable. We have a mission to save Thoroughbred racing and we welcome these new NTA Founding Members who have joined to help us and the sport."

The top three are all coming off the layoff: highweight **Windsharp** (Lear Fan) has not started since running fourth against colts in the GI Hollywood Turf Cup December 15 and is winless since taking the GI San Luis Rey S. over the boys nearly one year ago; **Donna Viola (GB)** (Be My Chief) looks for her fourth straight but has not been out since rallying for a half-length score in the GI Yellow Ribbon November 3; and French import **Red Roses Story (Fr)** (Pink {Fr}), making her U.S., debut, was last seen winning the G1 Prix Royal Oak at Longchamp October 27--the lightly raced mare has never been worse than second while racing against the colts in six of seven starts and bested San Luis Rey starter **Rainbow Dancer (Fr)** by a head when second in a listed event last April.

The 1995/96 Australian Horse Of The Year **Octagonal (NZ)** (Zabeel {NZ}, by *Sir Tristram) aims to become the highest earner in Australian racing history Saturday as he bids for his second straight in this race. Only Super Impose (NZ) has earned more. The four-year-old Octagonal will be aiming to win his 10th Group One race, and his third in a row following the Chipping Norton S. and the Australian Cup, when he lines up against 13 opponents. His main rivals will be the recent G1 Ranvet S. winner **Arkady (Aus)** (Myocard {NZ}, by Ivory Hunter), the Melbourne Cup third **Skybeau (NZ)** (Dahar), the three-year-old **Ebony Grosve (NZ)** (Grosvenor {NZ}, by *Sir Tristram) and the American-bred **Istidaad** (Chief's Crown), winner of the recent G 2 St. George S. This will be Octagonal's final race at Rosehill, but not his swan song, as he is expected to finally bow out next month when he contests the G1 Queen Elizabeth S. at Randwick.

SEAGRAMS OUT OF MEADOWLANDS MIX

Preliminary talks with Seagram's, the Canadian distillery which had shown an interest in buying the rights to the name of the Meadowlands racetrack, have been halted after New Jersey Governor Christie Todd Whitman yesterday vetoed a proposal which could have changed the name of the track to Seagrams Park at the Meadowlands. Said Whitman, "Our state policy is clear--we want to encourage young people to avoid the use of alcohol and tobacco. Selling the naming rights of a state facility to a company that manufactures and sells alcohol or tobacco products would be counter to our policy and would send a terribly conflicted message to impressionable adolescents." Although Seagrams is now out, the Meadowlands could still seek another company willing to buy the rights to their name. "If we proceed (with the proposal), it will be in a different direction," read a statement released by the New Jersey Sports and Exposition Authority, which operates the Meadowlands.

Moving to boost California's breeding industry and comply with the intent of a new state law, the California Horse Racing Board instructed all racing associations Friday to develop and report on their plans to distribute 10 percent of their total stakes purses to stakes restricted to California-breds. While the new law does not specifically mandate the running of 10 percent Cal-bred stakes, Senator Ken Maddy, the author of the enacted law, has introduced a second bill this year that would make this goal an actual mandate.
