OCTAGONAL SETS AUSTRALIAN EARNINGS RECORD

Starting the 9-10 favourite, the 1995/96 Australian Horse Of The Year **Octagonal (NZ)** (Zabeel {NZ}, by *Sir Tristram) captured Saturday's G1 Mercedes Classic over a mile and a half at Rosehill and established himself as the richest earner in Australian racing history. With yesterday's purse of \$538,230, Octagonal has now bankrolled \$4,621,047. But the John Hawkes-trained four-year-old had a tough battle to write his name in the history books. He was badly placed entering the straight and his rider, Shane Dye, had to exercise all his skill to find an opening. Once through the pack, Octagonal found his usual strong finish and powered home to catch last week's G1 Ranvet S. **Arkady (Aus)** (Myocard {NZ}, by Ivory Hunter) in the final strides to win by a short head, with **Istidaad** (Chief's Crown) a neck further back in third. Hawkes was not certain that "The Big O," as Octagonal is nicknamed by punters, had got up to win. "I thought the other horse had won on the line," he said. "It's absolutely sensational. He's a champion and only champions do what he's done today. No one did him any favours today and he still blows them out of the water. He's had so many knockers, but no matter what the critics say about him, he just gets back up and serves it up to them." The race was sadly marred by the death of Brisbane Cup hero **Dupain (NZ)** (*Sir Tristram), who had to be destroyed after shattering both front sesamoids.

GOLDEN SLIPPER TO GUINEAS

Unbeaten **Guineas (Aus)** (Crown Jester {Aus}) gave Octagonal's trainer, John Hawkes, and owners Jack and Bob Ingham a Group One "double" when he grabbed the victory in Saturday's G1 Tooheys Golden Slipper S. over six furlongs at Rosehill by a nose from **Encounter (Aus)** (Tierce {Aus}), with the filly **Regal Chamber (Aus)** (Archregent), a 66-1 shot, a length and three-quarters away third. The 15-8 favourite **General Nediym (Aus)** (Nediym {Ire}, by Shareef Dancer), who had every chance early, was another two lengths back in fourth. Starting at odds of 6-1, Guineas took the lead inside the final furlong, but was immediately challenged by 7-2 Encounter, ridden by Shane Dye. Encounter appeared certain to win but, for no apparent reason, suddenly veered to his left and lost his chance. "This is the day we've been waiting for," said Hawkes, winning the Golden Slipper for the first time. "Guineas was always our best chance. This is the best day I've ever had at the races, without a doubt."

Making her first start of the season after more than three months off, Windsharp returned to the course where she is three-for-four lifetime trying the abbreviated distance of a mile and an eighth for the first time. The slight choice in the seven-horse field, she bided her time in fifth through a moderate six furlongs in 1:13.49, swung four-wide into the stretch and wore down pacesetter Wheatly Special in the final yards. "The pace was slow, but this turf course is in better shape than it has ever been," said winning jockey Eddie Delahoussaye. "It's fairer with horses coming from off the pace. I think this mare is better than last year. She's a lot stronger; her breathing is good. We weren't sure if a mile and an eighth would be enough distance for her, but (trainer) Wally Dollase said she should be able to handle it. Well, she did." Dollase said the top turf mare, winner of last year's GII San Luis Obispo H. and GI San Luis Rey at a mile and a half over the boys, would go next in either the GI San Juan Capistrano H. against colts at a mile and five-eighths April 20, or the GII Santa Barbara H. at a mile and a quarter in her own division the day before.

Executive Director Sam Ramer said, "The NTA has the potential to provide the Thoroughbred industry a uniform, strategic goal for the future accompanied by a business plan sensitive to the needs of the industry. Our Board of Directors endorses the concept of owners taking the responsibility for the marketing and pricing of the product." But he added, "This endorsement does contain an undeniable concern. Namely, the pricing component will impact tracks that are net importers. By registering this reservation while declaring our confidence in the quality of the members of the NTA Policy Board, we feel we are supporting the initiative while placing in their trust our concerns."

"I wouldn't normally have brought her back so quickly, but there aren't many stakes opportunities at this time of year for three-year-old fillies on the turf," said winning trainer Angel Penna Jr. The talented turf runner could come back in the Palisades S. at Keeneland April 17. If not, "I'll just give her some time off," said Penna.
