### FLEMENSFIRTH IMPRESSIVE IN DUBAI WORK

**Flemensfirth** (Alleged) improved his odds for next Saturday's Dubai World Cup at Nad Al Sheba after an impressive work yesterday. The five-year-old bay's chances in the \$4 million race were slashed to 10-1 after a gallop with French hopeful **Helissio (Fr)** (Fairy King) in which the pair worked a mile on the main track with John Gosden's Flemensfirth finishing at least three lengths ahead of the Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe winner. Helissio's connections were non-committal afterwards, saying that the four-year-old did not enjoy having the sand kicked in his face. His rider Olivier Peslier enigmatically said that the horse was not really trying, so it is difficult to gauge what to make of this workout. Unraced so far this year, Flemensfirth is a Group 1 winner in France and Italy and has scored five victories in eight starts for earnings of \$366,919. GI Canadian International and Japan Cup winner **Singspiel (Ire)** (In the Wings {GB}), also worked well at Nad Al Sheba and is third favorite for the mile-and-a-quarter event on the sand. The present leading odds for the World Cup with most British bookmakers: **Siphon (Brz)** (Itajara {Brz}), 11-4; **Sandpit (Brz)** (Baynoun {Ire}), 4-1; Singspiel, 5-1; Helissio, 11-2; **Formal Gold** (Black Tie Affair {Ire}), 7-1; **Kammtarra** (Zilzal), 7-1; Flemensfirth, 10-1.

Marlin, winner of last year's GI Hollywood Derby, was looking to make his first trip to the winner's circle since that December 1 effort. Most recently the bay colt had run fourth over the main track in the March 2 GI Santa Anita H. Back on the grass for this affair, the colt was made the 2-1 favorite. He settled into fourth for the early going, rallied three-wide turning for home to take the lead into the stretch. Peckinpah's Soul, making his American debut after arriving from France last week, was forced to steady sharply leaving the turn and finished with a rush to be third, but did not return to be unsaddled and was vanned off the track. "When he broke in front, I was going to let him march to the lead, but he didn't want to," explained winning jockey Chris McCarron. "He just totally shut it off and just galloped around there. He had a great position. I wasn't going to press the issue if he didn't want the lead. He exploded right when I needed him to. I could hear (Kent) Desormeaux's horse (Sunshack) coming and I thought he was going to catch us. But somehow Marlin was able to grind it out and find some more." Marlin's bankroll swelled over \$1 million with his win here. "I had one champion on the grass and that was Steinlen," winning trainer D. Wayne Lukas said after the race. "Marlin is every bit as good as him." Marlin may start next in the GI San Juan Capistrano Apr. 20.

The 1996 King George VI & Queen Elizabeth S. winner **Pentire (GB)** (Be My Guest) will stand in the Southern Hemisphere later this year following the announcement of an agreement between John Thompson's Rich Hill Thoroughbreds at Walton near Matamata in New Zealand and the Shadai Stallion Station in Japan, where the chestnut stallion is standing his first season at stud. Pentire won six of his seven starts as a three-year-old in 1995, including the G1 Champion S., G2 King Edward VII S. and the G2 Great Voltigeur S. Pentire will be the first stallion to stand at Rich Hill and his service fee in New Zealand will be \$11,000. John Thompson said: "The opportunity to stand Pentire was too good to turn down. My two partners and I have gathered some excellent premier quality mares and Pentire will get our full support."

**Kilmore Quay** (Yachtie {Aus}, by Broad Reach {NZ}) won Saturday's G1 \$82,873 Manawatu Sires Produce S. over six furlongs at Awapuni, Palmerston North in New Zealand. Trained by John Wheeler, Kilmore Quay won by two easy lengths on a wet track over favored **Dandy Dancer (NZ)** (Citidancer {Ire}), with **Petrov** a half length away in third. Wheeler, plans to aim Kilmore Quay for the G1 Eilerslie Sires Produce S. March 31 in Auckland. Kilmore Quay comes from the first crop of the stallion Yachtie, who was fifth in the 1992 Golden Slipper in Sydney and who stands at Grangewilliam Stud at South Taranaki, where the 1995 Melbourne Cup hero Doriemus was bred.
