COMPLETE BREEDERS' CUP STAKES

PROGRAM RELEASED Highlighted by 42 graded stakes and offering a total of \$13.5 million in purses, Breeders' Cup Limited has released the balance of its 1997 National Stakes schedule. Now in its second year, the program consists of 85 stakes funded by Breeders' Cup Ltd. and 45 participating racetracks. Nineteen races on this year's schedule will receive \$100,000 from the Breeders' Cup, including the GII \$400,000 Breeders' Cup Shoemaker Mile June 15 at Hollywood Park, the GIII \$300,000 Saratoga Breeders' Cup August 24, the GIII \$250,000 Niagara Breeders' Cup H. at Woodbine August 31 and the GII \$300,000 Turfway Breeders' Cup September 13. Said President D. G. Van Clief, Jr., "Last year we received very enthusiastic responses from our racetrack partners with whom we created a schedule to upgrade the quality of our series. We look forward to working with the tracks again in supporting their individual racing programs."

TRIPLE CROWN LATE NOMINATIONS CLOSE

Late nominations for the 1997 Triple Crown close today, Saturday, March 29. The nominations, at a cost of \$6,000 each, must be received by midnight, or be postmarked on this date. The \$5 million Visa Triple Crown Challenge bonus goes to the three-year-old who can sweep the GI Kentucky Derby May 3, GI Preakness May 17, and GI Belmont S. June 7.

PERTEMPS TO SPONSOR GUINEAS AGAIN

Newmarket's 2000 Guineas, set for May 3, and 1000 Guineas, to be run May 4, were in danger of losing their sponsorship this year, but, at the 11th hour, Pertemps has stepped in to back both Classics for the second year running. The largest personnel recruitment agency in Britain, Pertemps will also sponsor the Doncaster St. Leger in September for the second time. Pertemps Chairman Tim Watts said Friday: "We are delighted to be continuing our Classic connection by sponsoring all three races this year."

After two days of good weather, the Nad Al Sheba track in Dubai was open for morning track work Friday. Trainer John Gosden put Flemensfirth (Alleged) through the starting gates in preparation for the big race. The five-year-old may have the best chance of the European contingent; he has breezed sharply over the track and is a Group 1 winner in France and Italy at the distance. Lightly raced, he has started only three times since September, 1995, but has won all three, taking back-toback runnings of the G2 Prix Dollar and then ending his two-race 1996 campaign with a game victory in the G1 Premio Roma November 10, his most recent outing. But the Americans are once again favored to dominate over the sand track. Siphon (Brz) (Itajara {Brz}) has taken six of his last seven and was most impressive in his latest, a three-length score in the GI Santa Anita H. March 2. Stablemate Sandpit (Brz) (Baynoun {Ire}) was second in that event in his very first start on the dirt. Formal Gold (Black Tie Affair {Ire}), a disappointing sixth in the Big 'Can, could be tough if he runs back to his first start of the season, a win over Eclipse champion Skip Away in the GI Donn H. February 8. Even Top (Ire) (Toponoora {Ire}) warmed up for the race yesterday, breezing a quarter-mile in :29.09.

According to a report in yesterday's *Racing Post*, steeplechaser **Aldaniti (GB)** (Derek H. {GB}), who carried jockey Bob Champion to victory in the 1981 Grand National, has died at the age of 27. The injury-plagued gelding was Champion's inspiration as he battled cancer before the pair's Grand National success. Retired in 1982 after falling at the first fence in that year's Grand National, Aldaniti had teamed with Champion in personal appearances to raise millions of dollars for cancer research. "I have lost something that was very close to me," Champion told the *Racing Post*. "Aldaniti showed as much strength and character in his career as I ever had to do. He was an absolute gentleman, who loved racing and his work for my Trust and relished the crowds who came to see him."
